Celebration For James Dilworth, II

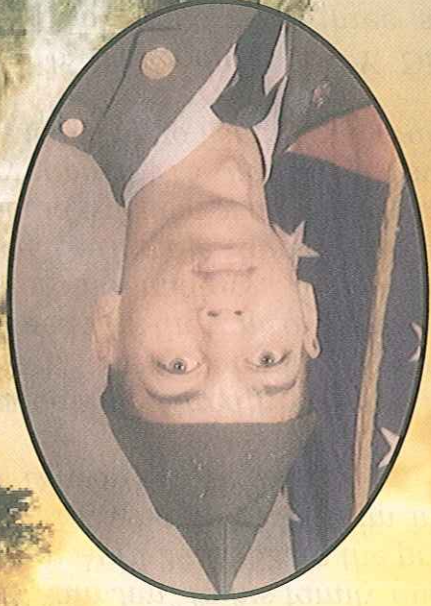
James Dilworth, II of Savannah, GA passed away July 9, 2016 at Hospice Savannah after a long illness.
