## *Gold Medal Awards*

Gold medal awards are given by Dubuque Senior High School to members of the graduating class who have been outstanding in certain activities sponsored by the school. The recipients of these awards have been selected primarily on the basis of their contribution to the given activity. School citizenship is always considered before any award is made at Senior. Competition for these awards is very keen, making it a real honor to be selected as a winner.

### **SCHOLARSHIP AWARD**

The scholarship award is given to the student who achieved the highest grade point average in the class of 1967.

### **SERVICE AWARDS**

Service awards are given to a senior boy and a senior girl who have been willing to assume positions of responsibility within the school and who have performed the duties with outstanding skill and devotion.

### **FOURTH ESTATE AWARD**

This award is made to a member of the staff of "The Fourth Estate," the school newspaper, who has made an exceptional contribution to the success of the paper.

### **SPEECH ARTS AWARD**

The Speech Arts Award goes to a student who has been prominent in one or in several phases of extra-curricular speech work.

### **ECHO AWARD**

This award is made to a member of the staff which produces the "Echo," the school year-book. It is based on an outstanding contribution in the business, editorial, lay-out, or photographic division of the work.

### **VOCAL MUSIC AWARD**

This award is used to recognize a member of a vocal organization who has been especially helpful in making the vocal program a success. It usually takes active participation for a three year period to earn this award.

### **INSTRUMENTAL MUSIC AWARD**

This award is made each year to the boy or girl judged to have contributed the most to the department during the three year period.

## *Special Awards*

### **AMERICAN LEGION AWARDS**

Each year Dubuque Post No. 6 of the American Legion presents a certificate of distinguished achievement and a medal to the boy and the girl who have shown, while at Senior High, those qualities of honor, courage, scholarship, leadership, service and character which are necessary to the preservation and protection of the fundamental institutions of our government and the advancement of society.

### **DI TELLA AWARD**

This award is in the form of a medal dedicated to the memory of the late Ferdinand di Tella, beloved director of the Senior High band and orchestra for many years. It is awarded to a boy or girl judged to have demonstrated outstanding musicianship.

### **HONOR SOCIETY AWARD**

The National Honor Society of Dubuque Senior High School each year presents an honor cup to a senior, showing qualities of leadership and service, and who has shown the greatest improvement in scholastic grades during his or her high school career.

### **IOWA STATE BAR ASSOCIATION CITIZENSHIP AWARD**

The Iowa State Bar Association has set up a state wide program in the high schools of Iowa to improve the understanding of our government, and the true function of the Constitution of the United States. Pursuant to this idea the association is offering citizenship awards to members of each high school graduating class in the state of Iowa. Awards are given in the ratio of one for each one hundred students in the class.

At Senior High School the recipients are selected through a combined rating obtained from their ranking in a test in American Government and the records they have made as active participating school citizens at Senior High School.

### **"D" CLUB AWARD**

This award is made to the major "D" winner who has earned the highest scholastic ranking for the past school year. The name of the winner is engraved on the Wilbur Dalzell trophy which remains permanently in the possession of Senior High School. In addition he receives a certificate commemorating the event.

### **PICKARD AWARD**

Several years ago Fannie H. Pickard and the late Benjamin F. Pickard set up a trust fund to provide an annual cash award to be given at commencement in memory of their son, Charles Benjamin Pickard. Ben was an esteemed member of the class of 1944 and was called to give his life on the field of battle in World War II.

The recipient of this award is selected by his classmates and the faculty, on the basis of those characteristics which were so well exemplified in the life of Charles Benjamin Pickard. These characteristics are: sincerity of effort in scholarship, excellency of character, willingness to sacrifice self for the good of his school; willingness to fight against obstacles, either mental or physical.

### **RONALD MEYER AWARD**

The Ronald Meyer Award was established by the Mathis-Pfohl Foundation to honor the memory of Lieutenant Ronald W. Meyer who gave his life in the Vietnam conflict. It is awarded to a member of the graduating class who reflects the qualities of scholarship, leadership, athletic ability, and patriotism so well exemplified by Lieutenant Meyer.

### **DUBUQUE ROTARY SERVICE AWARD**

This award is made to an outstanding senior who best exemplifies the Rotary "Four-way Test."
