Touring Report: There was none.

Old Business: The Pigman is August 16-17. There are 10 turnaround points that volunteers are needed to attend. Volunteers will meet at the Palo Mini Mart at 6:45 to be disbursed to their assigned locations. October 5 is the annual meeting to be held at Squaw Creek Park in Marion. Brandon Whyte will be the guest speaker. Election of officers will be at that time, the treasurer position being the most crucial to fill. A president, secretary and treasurer are needed to sustain charter club status, without which we will lose out RAGBRAI participation.

New Business: The Cedar Valley Nature trail is scheduled to be paved from Schultz Road through Center Point. It was suggested that the club donate monies for that project-\$3000.00-\$5000.00 designated specifically for this paved trail only. The proposal will be presented to the membership at the annual meeting.
