Mount Olympus, 30 yr Hike

Optional activity

When: Saturday August 10, 2013

<u>Time:</u> Meet at Einstein Bagels on Wasatch Blvd at 8:30 a.m. (You can grab a bagel if you want and we can carpool to the trailhead) Hike will start around 9:00.

Hike info:

Name	Mount Olympus
Hike Length	6.4 miles round trip
Elevation gain	4,200 up
Summit elevation	9,026 feet
Time to complete	5.5 hours (30 minutes of those spent at the top)

The trail divides up into three portions. The first part is mostly out into the open and is a series of switchbacks with little cover from the sun. There are a lots of rock and it's mostly uphill, though the grade isn't too bad.

The second part is MUCH steeper and a large part of it goes through a fairly dense area of the oak trees here so a good share of the sun is blocked. There are no switchbacks here and it is up hill ALL the way. You will need to bring plenty of water, sunscreen, and moleskin or tape for possible blisters.

The third part is a scramble up a very vertical rocky part of the mountain. But before that you do reach a local summit. This is a very pretty area with many trees. At this point your elevation gain has been more than 3000 feet and you have gone over 3 miles. If this is as far as you go it is still well worth the climb.

The final climb is a near vertical climb of 500-600 feet. It requires you to use your hands and feet to make it. The views are spectacular in all directions. It'll be well worth it! What better way to share this accomplishment then with old friends and classmates. You are also welcome to bring your partners, spouses and older children along with you.
