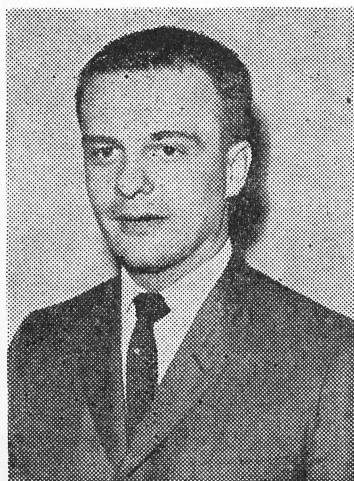
BERGEN COUNTY MUSIC EDUCATORS ASSN.
