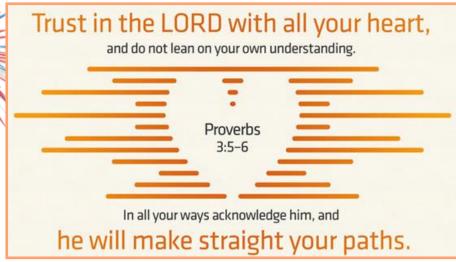

"Filling the Gap Lunches for Kids" is feeding children at more locations this summer

Partners for Wichita, through its "Filling the Gap Lunches for Kids" program, will serve lunches to children and youth ages 18 and under before school starts. The lunches are available at no charge and will be served Monday through Friday, July 30-August 10, from noon until 1:00 p.m., at 19 locations in Wichita, Haysville, and Oaklawn. (See list below.)

"Filling the Gap Lunches for Kids," in partnership with Kansas Food Bank and hundreds of volunteers, serves a nutritious sack lunch along with milk, fresh fruit, and healthy snacks to over 800 children a day during the gap between the end of the school summer lunch program and the beginning of school.

This year, there are two new sites, Dawson United Methodist Church (2741 S. Laura) and Mt. Olive Tabernacle of Praise (909 N. St. Paul St.) and a returning site, Grant Chapel AME (2750 N. Hillside) to better serve those at risk of hunger.

Your help is needed to gather individually packaged healthy snacks to supplement the lunches. Partners for Wichita will hold its "snack donation day" for Filling the Gap on July 13 from 11:00 a.m. - 1:00 p.m. at the Kansas Food Bank, 1919 E. Douglas. Please bring healthy, single-serving, packaged snack items such as fruit cups, peanut butter or cheese crackers, pretzels, healthy snack or cereal bars, raisins or dried fruit packets, etc.

Grants and donations from individuals, congregations, businesses, and organizations make the Filling the Gap Lunches for Kids program possible, along with the over 200 volunteers who staff the sites. Meals will be offered again during spring break.
