When was the last time you reflected on the mighty works of God in your life? When did you last take the time to offer your enthusiastic praise? Jesus offers to us in Matthew 11:28-29, "Are you tired? Worn out? Come to me. Get away with me and you'll recover your life. I'll show you how to take a real rest. Learn the unforced rhythms of grace."

We know what is coming this Holy Week, as it comes every Holy Week. One of the greatest journeys of our faith is this transformation from palms to crucifixion to resurrection. One of the greatest challenges of our faith is to live through this transformation each year and experience all of it. On this Palm Sunday, may we truly wave our palms with enthusiastic praise, remembering all of the mighty works that we have witnessed, and those that are yet to be ... hallelujah!

Community Rewards Program

Dillons Dollars - Exciting New Changes

Dillon's has improved their reward system for non-profits! You no longer have to use a specific gift card that you reload regularly. Now all you have to do is connect your PLUS card to Dawson and all purchase you make where you swipe your PLUS card will be credited toward Dawson. Below are instructions for signing up for this new COMMUNITY REWARDS SYSTEM:

- 1) Visit: www.dillons.com/communityrewards. Select "Sign In" if you already have a Dillon's account OR create an account. You must have an account to use the rewards program.
- 2) Once your account has been set up, scroll to the bottom of your Account Summary where you will see Community Rewards. Click Enroll.
- 3) If you are a first time user, you may have to complete some personal information. Once that is done, it will ask you to enter the first three letters of the organization you wish to support or their NPO number. Enter 10105 (or DAWSON). You will then select Dawson United Methodist Church.

If you need help setting up your community rewards account online, please let us know and we will find someone to help you get things set up. One final note: Your Dillon's Gift Cards that were used for the previous "Dillon's Dollars' program will no longer provide a percentage back to Dawson, but they will still continue to function as Gift Cards. In other words, if you have any balance remaining on the cards, that balance will continue to be good for purchases at Dillon's, but you will need to swipe your PlusCard in order to get a percentage back to Dawson!!!
