BROOKSIDE & DAWSON CO-OPERATIVE FOOD PANTRY

Many of our ladies have, in the past, spent some Friday afternoons volunteering their time at Brookside UMC used clothing store, in a room which shared space with a Hunter Clinic Satellite. Much has changed. Hunter has moved into a separate building; so now more than twice the amount of merchandise is on display in the clothing store, and Brookside has added a food ministry – all of this accomplished with a sustained congregation of twelve.

Why a food ministry? Because the area they serve is a very depressed neighborhood. Many of the residents rely on public busses and their own feet for transportation. Sending them to Open Door is not a feasible option.

How can we help? By directing our Food Barrel contents to help Brookside's Food Ministry. This is why we are asking you to continue bringing canned goods for the barrel. On the Second Sunday after the Potluck Dinner we will load up the food collected for a monthly delivery to Brookside. On the second Sunday after we have fed ourselves, we will help feed our neighbors.
