

I hope the holidays were very joyous for all of our USS Columbus veterans and their families.

Dianne and I are in Panama City Beach, FL where we have been going for the past six years for the winter months of January and February. We head home on March 1.

I made a date mistake or AFRI made the mistake and I did not catch it but one of our members did. We normally schedule our reunions so they do not conflict with the Jewish holidays but the original schedule was right during their holidays. I was able to successfully get the dates changes so our Jewish shipmates will be able to make the reunion. REMEMBER there is a date change for the 2013 reunion.

I have a list of tours and unofficial pricing for the Branson reunion. I will provide a copy so Rich Boyd, Newsletter editor can include it in this newsletter. Remember, the pricing and schedule is subject to change until it is official from AFRI. I am providing it for your planning purposes at the reunion. I agreed to an aggressive tourschedule with two tours per day on two days.

There is so much to do in Branson and I'm sure many of you will seek your own schedule of entertainment. Remember, all of our tours will be bus transportation so the cost will be approximately \$40.00 more than window ticket prices

I have already been contacted by shipmates about the location and dates for the 2013 reunion so somehow the information is getting out. I did put reunion information out on the Facebook page for the Cruisers Sailors and CG-12 pages.

I also have contacted John Grosvenor who maintains the USS Columbus.org website. John is retiring shortly and told me he will commit more time to bringing the site up to date.

2014 Reunion:

I wish I had good news about the 2014 reunion hotel negotiations but I don't have any good news about Savannah. The hotels are not giving us any concessions. The complementary rooms for the hospitality, ships store and business meeting would have to be paid for or rented by the association. These rooms would cost us \$500 per

day. The general room rate was \$142.00 with \$15-20 per day parking fees and no free transportation from the airport. I feel this is way beyond our means and I have a survey out to many of the board members and other members who have attended most of the reunions for their opinion on one of two proposals. Jacksonville, FL is the backup for Savannah but AFRI gave me a recommendation of Charleston, SC. So the survey is Jacksonville or Charleston. We have never held a reunion in Jacksonville whereas we did have a reunion in Charleston in the early 1990's. If my sample survey favors Charleston, then I will have to get a major vote in favor of Charleston from the Board in order to process with Charleston otherwise, I can process with Jacksonville without a vote.

Delinquent Dues:

Bob Miller and Rich Boyd have been busy sending delinquent letters this year so check the dues date on your mailing label. If the date behind your name is 2011 or earlier, you are two or more years behind and will be not receive the newsletter after this issue. To maintain your membership and continue to receive your newsletter, you need to pay the current fiscal years dues to remain active. That is \$25.00 to keep your membership active and current. You can prepay as many years as you may desire to avoid getting on the delinquent list.

Board Elections:

This year is an election year for three director positions. Normally, I would have the nominating committee contact each board member for their self nomination. It has been very difficult to put a nominating committee together, so I'm going to try something different this year as I did last year. All positions are filled at this time, so unless I hear form a current one year director that they do

not want to continue on the board I will treat it as a self nomination. If I receive any rejections, I will form a nominating committee to seek interested member's) for the open position's). If anyone is interested in any position, let me know so I can put your name on the ballot.


