The valedictorian and salutatorian have been selected for the Class of 1968 at Clarke County High School.



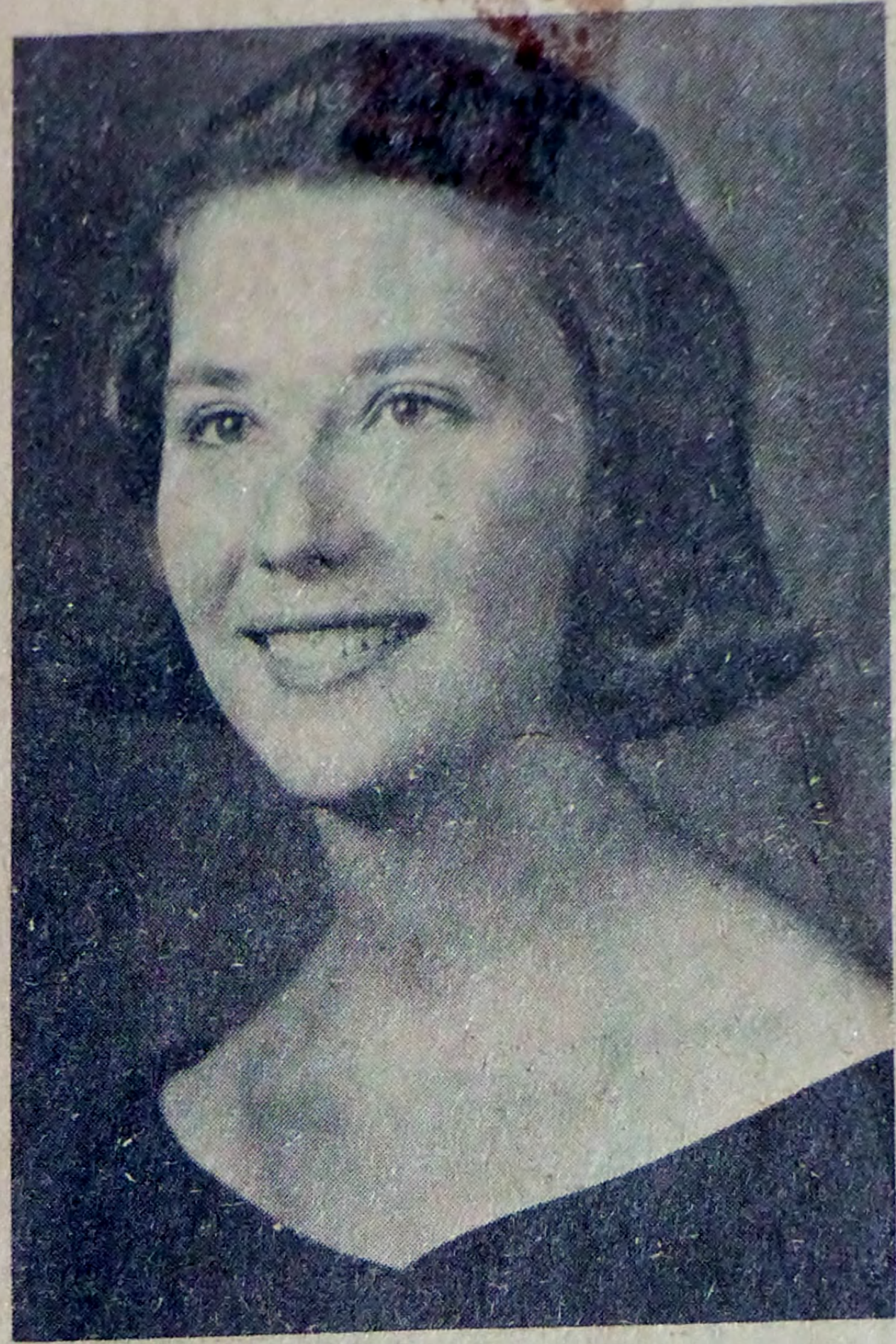
