CCHS Seniors To See Shakespeare's Macbeth

The seniors at Clarke County High School are eagerly awaiting their chance to see the Wayside Theater's production of William Shakespeare's "Macbeth". The seniors will journey to Middletown for the performance on this Friday, February 16.

The scenes and narration from Macbeth, which will be produced by Michael Procaccine, will complete the seniors' study of Macbeth with Mrs. Alice Loope, senior English teacher at CCHS. Particular emphasis was laid on the seniors' character analyses of Macbeth and Lady Macbeth, and this is the same approach which the Wayside production will present.

The week-day matinees of Macbeth will also be attended by other area schools during the week. Performances for the general public will be at 8:30 p.m. on Saturdays and 2:30 p.m. on Sunday afternoons, and the production will be presented from February 13 through February 24. Tickets are \$1.00 for students and school personnel, and \$2.50 for the general public.
