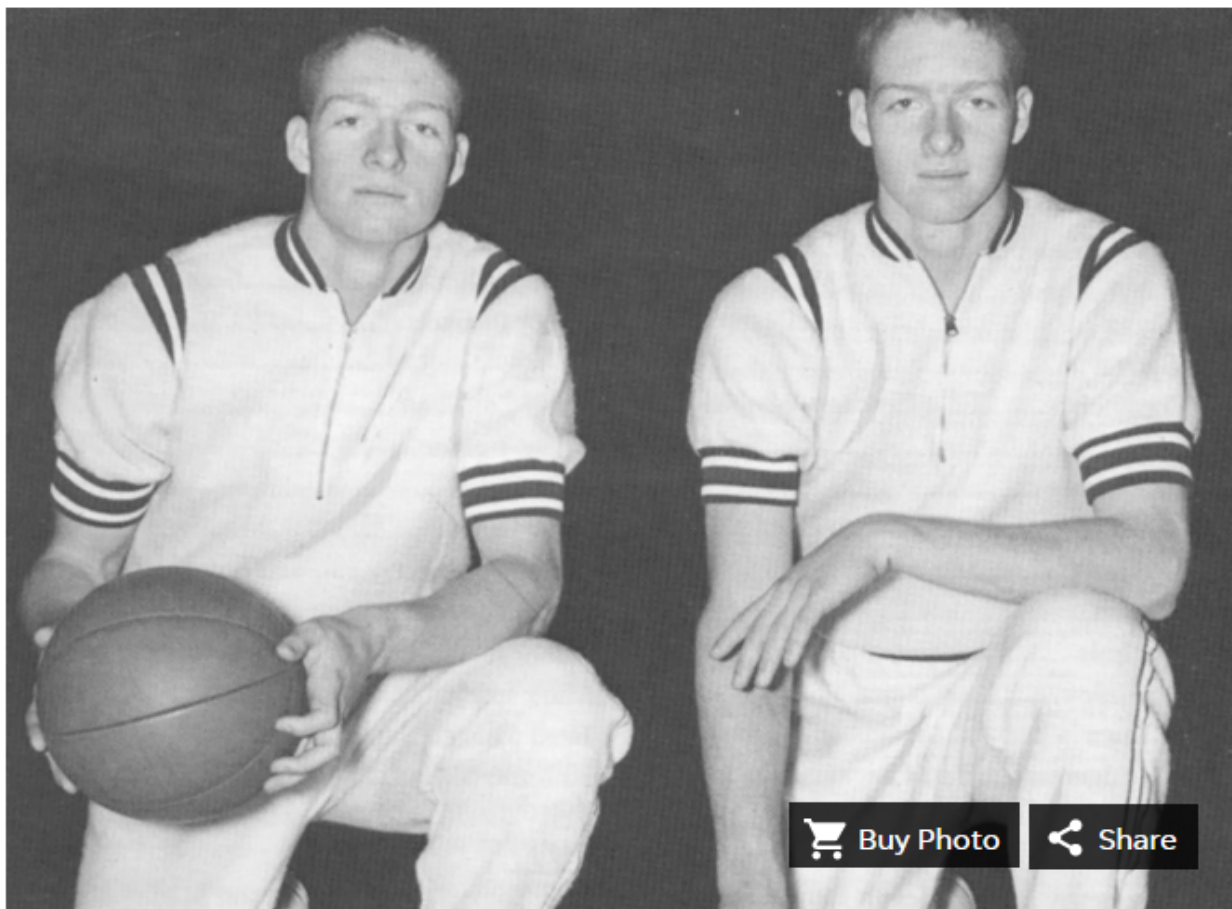

The Van Arsdale brothers, Tom and Dick, shared Mr. Basketball honors in 1961 and led Manual to the state finals.

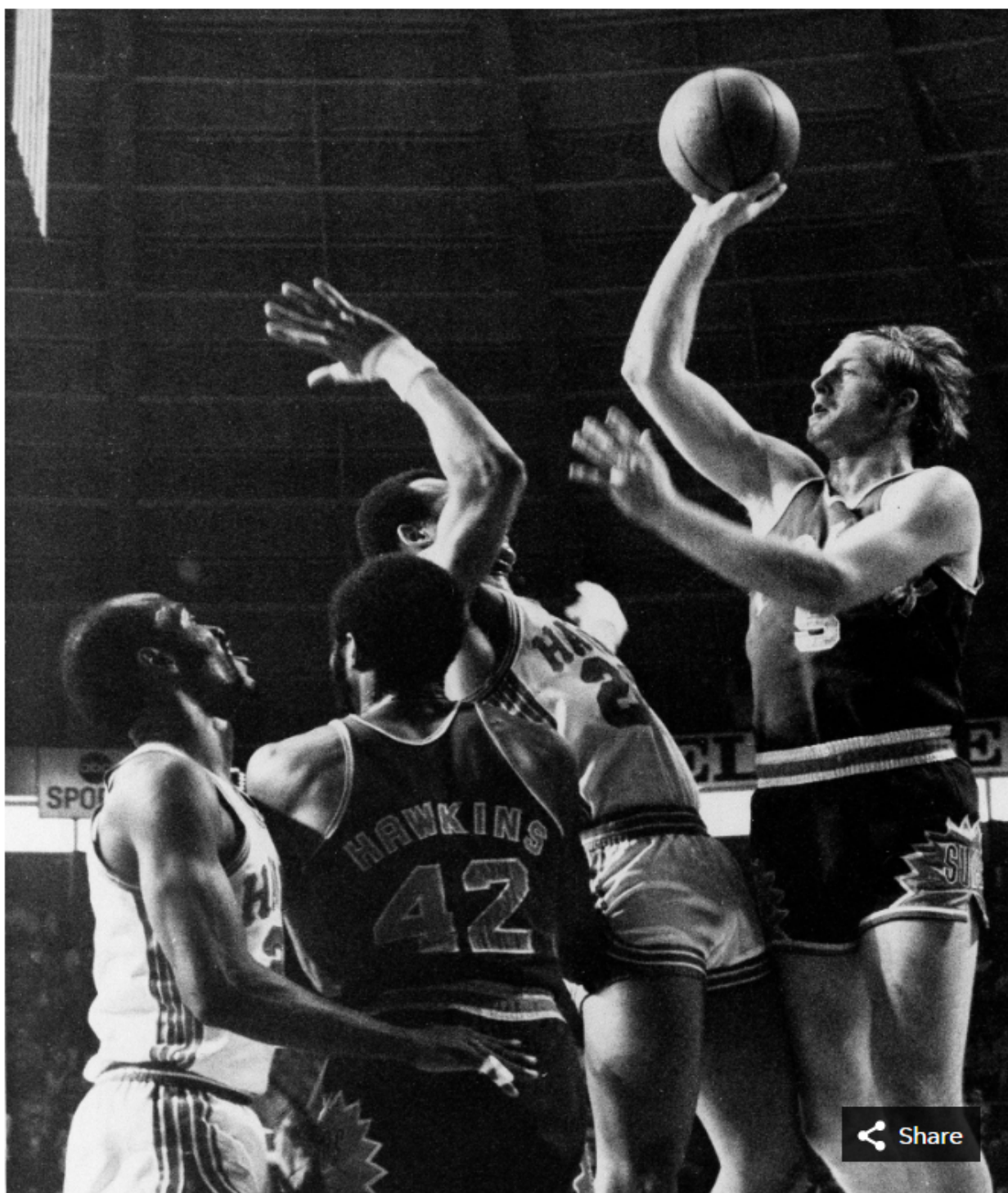

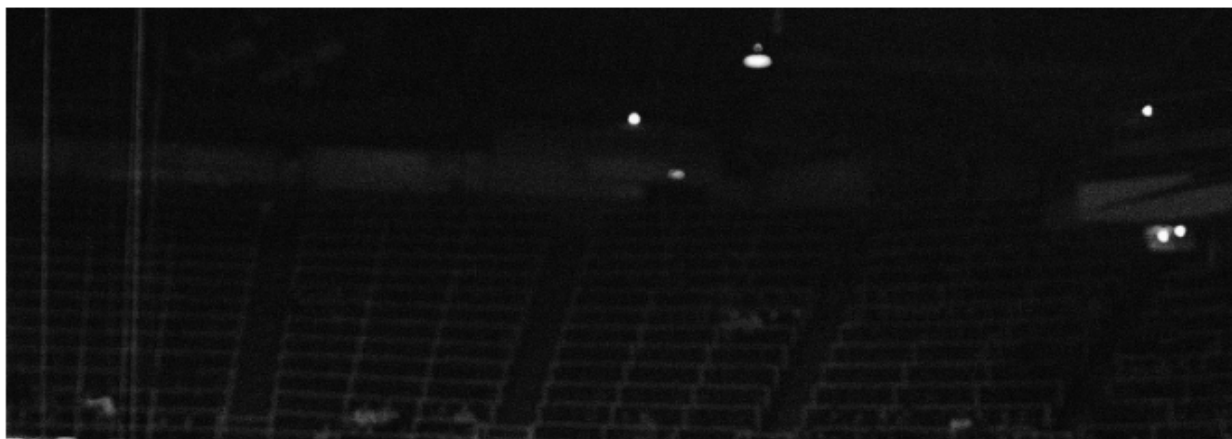

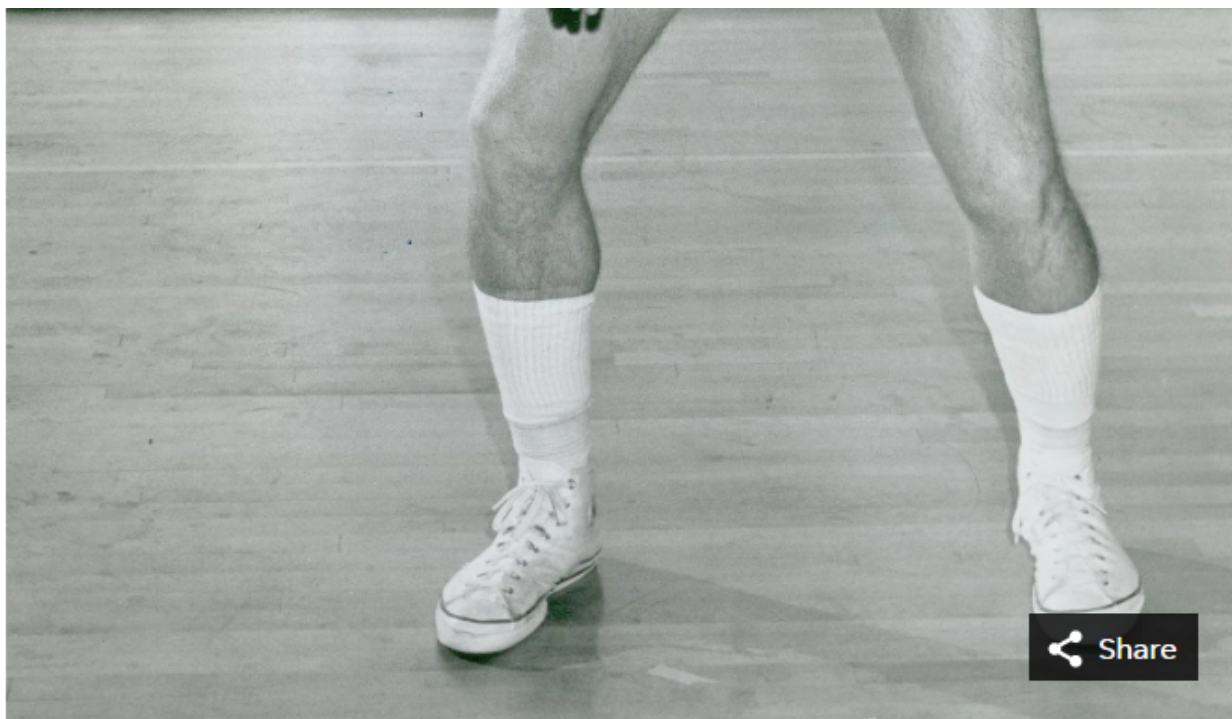

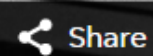

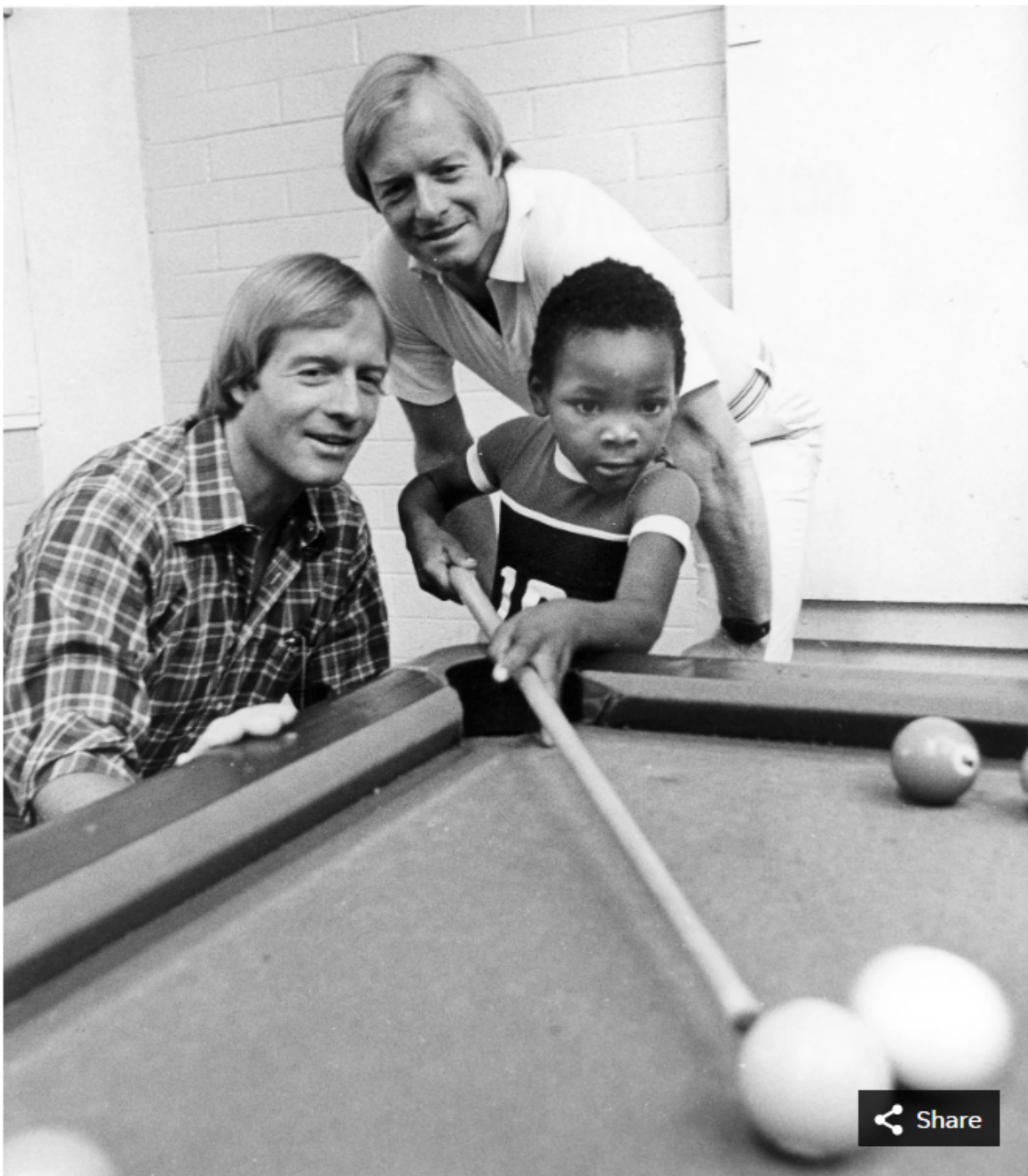
