## We are so excited to have you join us for the October 19-23 2017 Wingfoot Heads West Reunion!!

Below is some information about how the weekend is shaping up and what some associated costs might be in addition to your travel and hotel. Hopefully, this is workable for everyone as we are really looking forward to a fun and memorable time together!

**Thursday, 10/19:** Laurie Mintz book signing for her book "Becoming Clitorate" at La Cocina. Meet and greet is at 6:30pm followed by a reading and book signing at 7:00pm. Food and drinks will be available for purchase from La Cocina.

**Friday, 10/20:** Dinner on the upper patio La Cocina starting at 6:30pm. Free time during the day for those who are there. Activity ideas to follow separately.

**Saturday, 10/21:** Breakfast at the hotel (\$5 per person) followed by a day trip to Sabino Canyon (can hike from the Visitor's Center or take a tram to various scenic stops throughout the canyon on a hop on/hop off tram) from 11:00am-3:00pm with a bag lunch from La Cocina. Rest Period and Coke Break back at the hotel afterwards to relax, hang by the pool, etc. That evening, Jo will be hosting a Mediterranean buffet dinner (vegetarian, vegan and gluten-free options available) and Evening Program at her house, including a cash bar, starting at 6:30pm. Activities will include an optional craft project, singing, Remember Whens, s'mores making, etc.

**Sunday, 10/22:** Brunch at La Cocina at 10:30am and dinner either back at Jo's or at another restaurant for those staying in with some free time in between.

Monday, 10/23: Brunch at Bentley's House of Coffee and Tea at 10:00am for those who are still in town.

A block of rooms is being held at **Hotel Tucson City Center**. Their phone number is **520-622-3000**. Please mention that you are with the Camp Wingfoot Reunion. Rooms with either a king bed or two queen beds are \$85 per night including tax. There is also a 2 bedroom (1 king and 2 queens) with a living room, kitchen and patio that can be used a the hospitality suite for \$350 a night if any group is interested in renting that. Please note that the hotel does offer a free shuttle to and from the airport, which you can communicate with them directly about if you would like to use that option.

In terms of reunion cost, the total is approximately \$150 per person. This cost includes four meals (Friday dinner, Saturday lunch, Saturday dinner and Sunday brunch), including tip, tax, non-alcoholic beverages, snacks and desserts and the rental of several 15 person passenger vans including gas and a driver (if anyone wants to drive, let us know!). Additional optional costs are cash bar Friday and Saturday nights and Sunday morning, a small fee for the Sabino Canyon tram and a small fee for the Evening Program craft project. Payments will be accepted at a later date, in the weeks immediately preceding the reunion.

Please RSVP as soon as possible if you are planning on attending. If you are still thinking about it, please let us know if you will be joining us by **September 15**.
