### Q4 To what extent do you agree or disagree with the following main event options at the reunion?

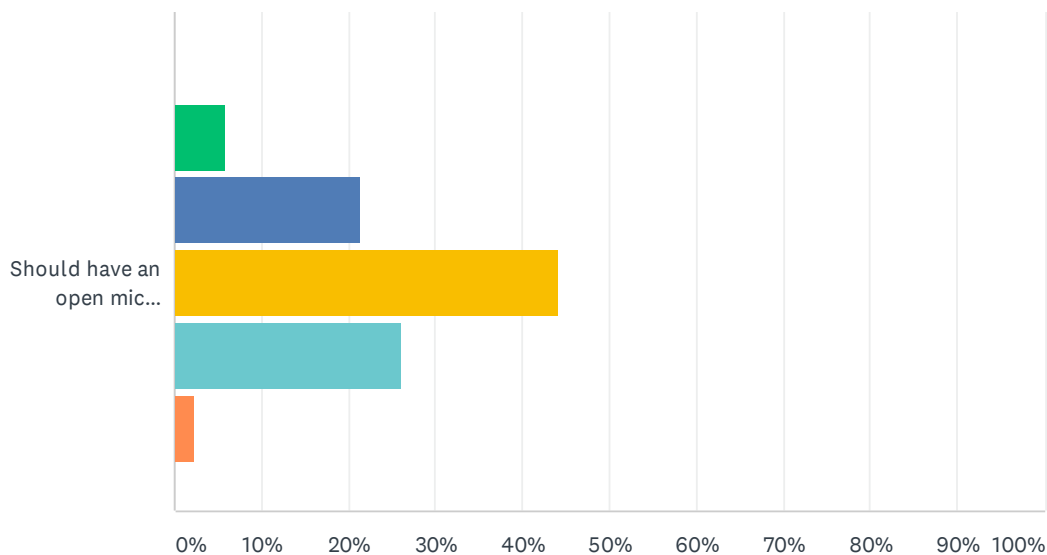

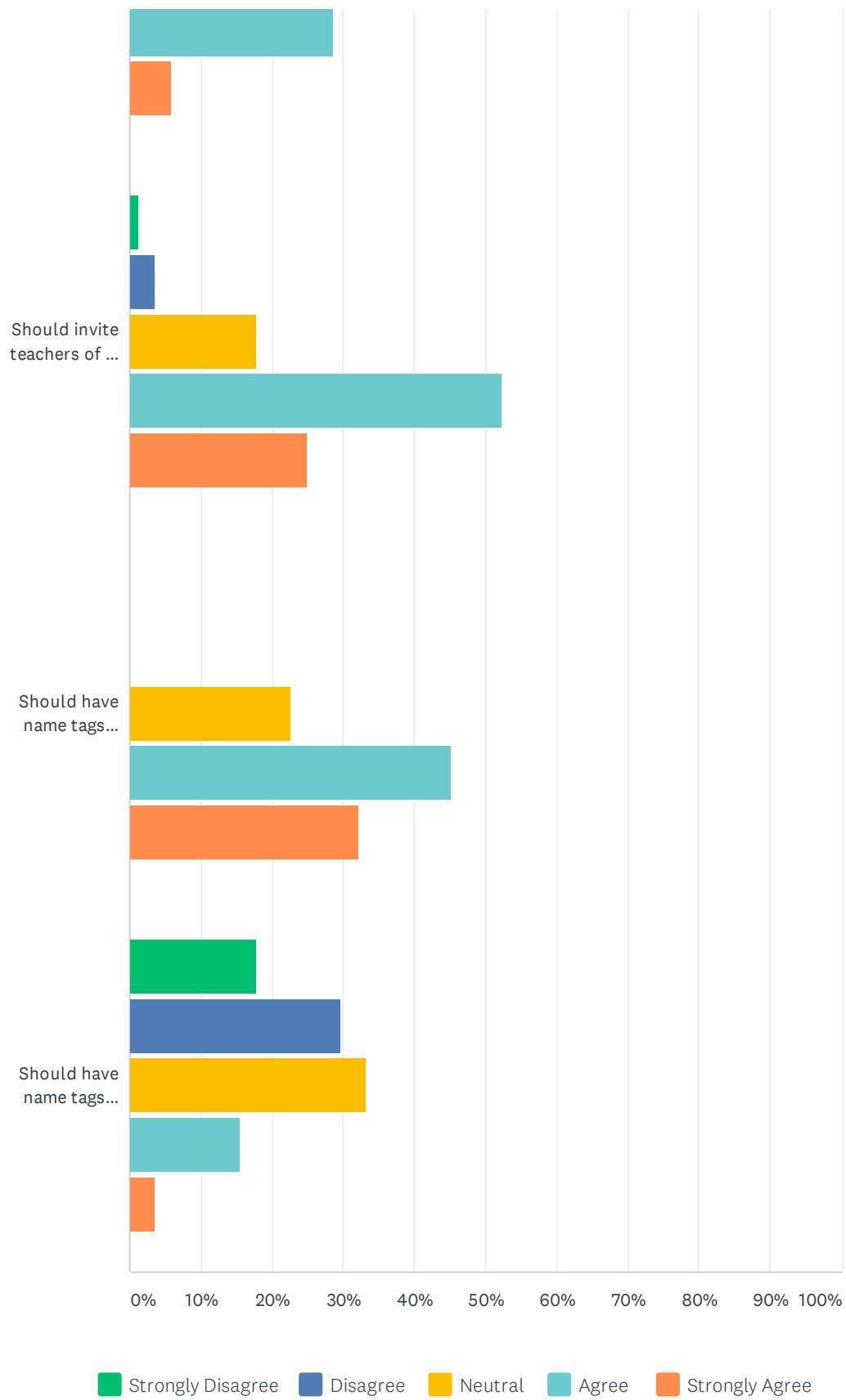


## Q6 To what extent do you agree or disagree with these statements about the reunion generally.
