

Josephine Ann Currier, daughter of Orlando (1887-1939) and Eugenia A. (Chainiere or Choiniere or Choirere) Currier, was born 17 July 1910, Owosso, Shiawassee County, Michigan. She graduated in 1928 from Okemos High School.



Josephine was the oldest child with a younger brother and two sisters. Sadly, in April 1920 Josephine's 5-month-old sister, Gretchen, died. Eight months later her 2 1/2-year-old sister, Agness Louise, died. Both little girls were interred Mt. Hope Cemetery, Lansing, Ingham County.

On 11 April 1936, Lansing, Josephine married Charles Irving Wilson. Charles, born 25 November 1904, died 27 January 1996, Gratiot County, Michigan. There were no known children.

Josephine may have died 13 August 2000 in Illinois according to the Social Security Death Index. Her surviving brother, Orla Lee Currier, born 8 March 1911, died 15 December 2006, Oregon. Orla Lee was a 1929 graduate of Okemos.
