

Annex: The Chieftain Fourteen Quiz

(2 points per each of the 50 questions)

1. Who was the first Chieftain to play basketball for the Michigan State Spartans? (John Shick)
2. Which Chieftain played on the OHS freshman squad, never on the OHS varsity squad, one season on the Spartans freshmen squad, three seasons on the Spartans varsity squad, and decades later became Chair of the MSU Board of Trustees? (Brian Breslin)
3. Which Chieftain is the son of the longtime “Voice of the Spartans”? (Joe Shackleton)
4. Which Chieftain was never a member of the regular Spartans varsity squad but yet as a freshman started in one varsity game? (Greg Lott)
5. Which Chieftain played on the Spartans varsity basketball squad on scholarship his freshmen year when he had enrolled at Michigan State on a golf scholarship? (Bob Fossum)
6. Of the all-time Top 50 Spartans, which Spartan is the highest-ranked on that list and also had a former Chieftain as a teammate—and who was that Chieftain? (Cassius Winston / Conner George)
7. Which Chieftain won the Miss Michigan Basketball title and helped Okemos to win its first girls Class B state championship? (Sue Tucker)
8. Who was the first Chieftain to score a three-pointer as a Michigan State Spartan? (Kris Weshinsky)
9. Which Chieftain was the only Chieftain to play in the WNBA? (Kristen Rasmussen)
10. Who was the first Chieftain to be on a Spartans squad that played in the NCAA Final Four? (Mike Kebler against North Carolina in the 2009 championship game)
11. Which Chieftain was the first-ever NCAA Division I player to be diagnosed on the autism spectrum? (Anthony Ianni)
12. Which Chieftain tallied the Spartans’ last point(s) of the 2013-2014 season and was that shot a free throw, a 2-pointer, or 3-pointer? (Dan Chapman / 3-pointer against Connecticut in the NCAA Regional Final)
13. Which Chieftain-cum-Spartan once scored 41 points in a high school game? (Conner George)

14. Which two Spartans, one a former Chieftain, had the opportunity to shoot six straight free throws and how many of the six free throw attempts did each Spartan make? (Shaun Respert made 5 and Conner George made 4)
15. Who were the two most recent female and male Chieftains to join a Spartans basketball squad as a preferred walk-on? (Tracy Nogle and Conner George)
16. Which two Chieftains were on scholarship at other universities for a period of time before transferring to MSU and becoming a member of the men's varsity basketball squad? (Greg Vanek and Anthony Ianni)
17. How many Chieftains played four years of Spartans basketball on a full-ride scholarship – and who were they? (Three - Sue Tucker, Kris Weshinsky, and Kristen Rasmussen)
18. Of “The Chieftain Fourteen” how many were a member of a Spartans basketball squad at least four seasons? (Nine - John Shick, Brian Breslin, Susan Tucker, Kris Weshinsky, Kristen Rasmussen, Mike Kebler, Tracy Nogle, Dan Chapman, and Conner George)
19. In what basketball season was there a former Chieftain on each of the men's varsity and women's varsity squads and who were those Chieftains? (Greg Vanek and Sue Tucker in the 1984-85 season)
20. In which season did the Spartans men's squad have three former Chieftains—and who were they? (2010-2011 – Mike Kebler, Anthony Ianni,, and Dan Chapman)
21. In how many of the past 60 seasons of Spartans basketball, and in what percentage of those seasons, has there been at least one former Chieftain on a Spartans basketball squad? ($37/60 = 62\%$)
22. What percentage of “The Chieftain Fourteen” graduated from Michigan State? (100%)
23. How many of “The Chieftain Fourteen” did not graduate from Okemos High? (Brian Breslin and Kris Weshinsky; both transferred to another high school)
24. Which two Chieftains who played basketball as a Spartan were members of a Okemos High basketball squad that won a State Championship in basketball? (Greg Vanek and Sue Tucker in 1981)
25. Which three Chieftains played only a single season as a Spartan? (Greg Lott, Bob Fossum, and Greg Vanek)

26. Which Chieftain (jokingly) claims to hold the “record” as the only Spartan to shoot 1000% on both field goals and free throws? (Greg Vanek)
27. Which Chieftain not on the men’s varsity basketball squad played in only one varsity game, in fact, started that game? (Greg Lott against #1 Indiana)
28. Who was the first male Chieftain to be inducted into the Okemos High Athletic Hall of Fame? (Bob Fossum)
29. Which Chieftains have coached basketball at one or another level? (Greg Lott, Kris Weshinskey, Kristen Rasmussen, and Anthony Ianni)
30. Of the six times that the Spartans men’s basketball squad has been ranked #1 in the AP Top 25 poll, how many of those times was there a Chieftain on that squad? (four times: Dan Chapman during the 2013-14 season; and Conner George during the 2015-16 and 2017-18 seasons and in week one of the 2019-2020 season)
31. Which two Chieftains helped the Spartans win a Big Ten Tournament? (Anthony Ianni and Dan Chapman in 2012; and Dan Chapman in 2014)
32. Which Chieftain, in which Big Ten Tournament, was fouled and challenged to make six consecutive free throw attempts—and how many of those attempts were made? (2017 Big Ten Tournament; Conner George; made four of six attempts)
33. Who were the only Chieftains to play in at least one National Invitation Tournament or Women’s National Invitational Tournament? (Kris Weshinskey & Kristen Rasmussen)
34. Who was the first Chieftain playing on a Spartans squad that qualified for the men’s NCAA Tournament? (1985: Greg Vanek)
35. Who was the first Chieftain to score a 3-pointer in a NCAA Tournament game? (Kris Weshinskey on March 22, 1992 against Cincinnati)
36. During the men’s 2013-2014 season which Chieftain three-point shot were the last points scored by a Spartan that season? (Dan Chapman’s three-pointer against Connecticut in the 2014 East Regional final game was his first three-pointer as a Spartan and the last points scored by a Spartan during the 2013-2014 season)
37. Which female Chieftain as of 2015 still held seven Top 25 MSU Women’s basketball individual records? (Sue Tucker)
38. Who was the first female Chieftain to score a 3-pointer as a Spartan? (Kristen Rasmussen)

39. Who was the first Chieftain to play on a Spartans women's squad that qualified for a NCCA Women's Tournament? (Kristen Rasmussen in 1997)
40. Who was the first Chieftain to play on a Spartan women's squad that qualified for the WNIT? (Kristen Rasmussen in 2000)
41. Who was the only Chieftain-cum-Spartan to play U.S.-based professional basketball after graduating from Michigan State? (Kristen Rasmussen in the WNBA)
42. Who was the only Chieftain to coach NCCA Division II and Division III basketball? (Kristen Rasmussen)
43. Which four Chieftains who played basketball for Michigan State have been inducted into the Okemos High School Athletic Hall of Fame? (Bob Fossum, Sue Tucker, Kristen Rasmussen, and Mike Kebler)
44. Who was the first Chieftain to appear in a You Tube video playing basketball as a Chieftain? (Conner George)
45. Who was the first Chieftain to appear in a YouTube video playing basketball as a Spartan? (Kris Weshinsky playing against Michigan on 1/29/92)
46. Which Chieftain helped his/her Spartans squad to finish no lower than 3rd place in the Big Ten Conference's regular season during four consecutive seasons? (Tracy Nogle – the Spartans Women's squad finished 2nd in 2010, 1st in 2011, tied for 2nd in 2012, and tied for 3rd in 2013)
47. Which Chieftain helped the Spartans to make it to the Semifinals in the Big Ten Tournament in 2010 and 2011, the Quarterfinals in 2012, and the Final in 2014? (Tracy Nogle)
48. Which Chieftain helped the Spartans qualify four years in a row for the Women's NCAA Tournament? (Tracy Nogle - the Spartans won their First Round game in 2010, 2011, and 2013 but lost their First Round game in 2012)
49. Which Chieftain, while totaling only 22 points in 70 career playing minutes across 25 career games, yet had a 50% field goal percentage (9-for-18) while also being a three-time Academic All-Big Ten? (Tracy Nogle)
50. Which three Chieftains have appeared in YouTube videos featuring aspects of their lives as adults? (Bob Fossum, Kristen Rasmussen, and Anthony Ianni)
