



ELAINE RUTH FOX, age 92 of Waseca, died on Saturday, May 19, 2018 at the Koda Living Community in Owatonna.

Born on January 3, 1926 in Lester Prairie, Elaine was the daughter of Clifford and Ella (Halvorson) Beise. She graduated from Lester Prairie High school and later from Macalester College – Miss Wood’s Kindergarten Primary Training School. She taught in the Waseca Public Schools.
