# **Treasurer's report**

for the year ended May 31, 2013

As was the case in prior years, the club continues to be in a very healthy financial position. It has cash on hand as at May 31, 2013 of \$1,401,821 pesos. Of this amount, \$115,850 pesos is payable to Altruism which amount was paid back during the month of June leaving a net cash balance of \$1,285,971. This is \$196,441 pesos higher than last year's balance of \$1,089,530 pesos. These high cash balances have been consistent for several years, as a result the club is looking at different options to increase our support to other worthwhile accredited charitable organizations.

Income was higher than plan by \$32,380 pesos mainly due to donations which were higher than plan by \$182,683 offset by Home tours which were under plan by \$32,140 pesos, and by clubhouse income which was under plan by \$99,090 pesos. For last year, although club house income was budgeted at \$124,500 pesos the actual amount achieved was \$234,215 which higher level was not achieved this year. This was mainly due to lower movie receipts because of the change of the day of the presentation and lower revenues for certain event fundraisers.

Expenses were \$8,410 pesos above plan, but fairly close to plan.

Charitable support costs were \$132,461 below plan which reinforces our obligation to increase our community services as stated above.

The budget to actual schedule is attached for the fiscal year June 1, 2012 to May 31, 2013.

Since meeting with the CMQ hospital, it looks like four (maybe even five) clinics will take place next year: March, May, July, and October have been scheduled.

We may have to change our surgical dates to Fridays as the hospital is working with the government to also lend space for surgeries through Seguro Social. This would mean consult days would be Thursdays, surgeries would be on Fridays and discharge would be Saturdays. I am in contact with the doctors to confirm that this will work for them

We have a new family in Bucerias ready to join our program. Bill and I are staying in very close contact with this family as they need a lot of support. We have taken them up to the dentist a couple of times already but right now, it is important that we work with them to help fatten up baby José. He is very underweight and the family is struggling.

We have provided them with special needs bottles and cans of formula. We are keeping in touch with them at least once a week so that, hopefully, the baby will be ready for his first surgery in March.
