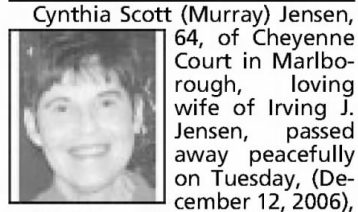


JENSEN, Cynthia Scott (Murray)
