

Our website is one of the biggest associations on Class Creator Network, and perhaps the second biggest site they have. True, there may

be bigger schools than BHS, but our alumni association is one of the oldest, having been around since 1986. Additionally, our association is special because we have given out at least six scholarships annually since 1986. Last year, our scholarships totaled \$12,500! This is all because we have great membership and sponsors. You can help by becoming one of those members; dues are small at only \$12 per year but, when added up, go a long way.

Beyond scholarships, our association has many other ongoing projects. One of our biggest tasks is our three-phase yearbook project. The first phase is to scan every yearbook picture for posting to our website (www.BensalemOwls.org). That means there are almost 28,000 pictures to scan and upload! John Bowan '77 and Lee Kirk '68 have given us a lot of help on this part of the project. As of this newsletter, we have just three years left to scan! This phase has taken almost three years of work, but I think the pictures are really great. Now you can check any year's photos by logging onto our site, clicking on "classmate profiles," selecting "year," and choosing "show yearbook pictures."

We have over 1,000 teachers' names on our site but want to share their pictures, too. As soon as we finish with uploading students' pictures, that will become our goal. Our final phase will be posting every single yearbook since 1925 online. We have already begun

To use our site, you can choose whether or not to log in via Facebook. If you choose to log in through Facebook, you will find that it's a pretty seamless process. Either way, once you create a profile on our site, only other members with profiles can see your shared information. Only registered members can view yearbook pictures, too, so be sure you have a profile if you want to take advantage of what we have to offer!

Another great member feature is our "In Memory" section, honoring those we have lost. Members receive notices whenever someone is added to this section. We know that everyone gets lots of e-mail these days, so you can choose to have this notice sent daily, weekly, or monthly to better fit your inbox needs. Please, if you know someone on this list and can say a few kind words, I would appreciate it. Military members also receive an American flag symbol, and I know many more alumni deserve to have one, too, so please alert us if you can help us out.

Alright, on to the big news! Our committee has recently voted to hold a reunion picnic for all of our alumni. We are looking into some locations and will let you know where it will be held soon. The tentative date is September 2016. Mark your calendars now and get ready for a big picnic! You can also check our site to see if your class is having a reunion soon-or even to see if you missed the last reunionby looking for the "Reunion Calendar" and "Reunion Archive." Your graduating class is not required to work with the Alumni Association, of course, but we have lots of resources and can really help promote your reunion.
