On October 8, 2011, the Class of 1961 held their 50th Year Class Reunion at Middletown Country Club. Ironically, we had 61



A Lasting Tribute... Bensalem High School Sports Hall of Fame

Ted Schueller, president of the Bensalem High School Sports Hall of Fame, says the Hall was started in 1967 by Dr. James I. Bardsley Jr. as a lasting tribute to those athletes & coaches that contributed their time, talents, dedications and self-discipline to the athletic programs.

As the newly elected President, Schueller says his committee's focus is to achieve Bardsley's goal. Schueller said after lying dorment for a period of time, there is a renewed interest in the Hall and in showcasing Bensalem's outstanding talent. He said the goals of the committee are: To select new inductees that best represent BHS for their accomplishments during their time at Bensalem.

To be eligible for the hall, Schueller said candidates must:

- Be out of school or coaching for five years;
- Have demonstrated outstanding school citizenships;
- Meet and/or exceed eligibility requirements of PIAA;
- Have demonstrated good academic standards as well as athletic standards and accomplishments;
- Have performed at high levels at league, district, and state levels

Schueller said the Hall will take on a greater visibility in December when the new Bensalem Physical Education Center opens. He said current plagues, trophies, and other Hall of Fame information will be moved into the lobby/trophy area of the new gym. We're looking for a copy of a 1987 Yearbook to complete our collection. 
