Budget cuts affect aid

If you're a college-bound senior needing financial aid, you should be filing your Financial Aid Form (FAF) now. (You know, the form that asks such pertinent questions as "How much did your great-grandmother make on February 29, 1932?") The FAF is used to apply for aid from your college and various government programs.

Unfortunately, Reaganomics is cutting back on student aid. Specifically, these cutbacks affect expect too much.

"Guaranteed Student Loans." The government has established that your parent's income must not exceed thirty thousand dollars to be eligible for these low-interest loans. Also, social security beneficiaries may not receive aid if they are not currently in college. But, these may not be the only cutbacks. There already is a fear that the government may reduce Pell Grants (Basic Grants) and/or Cutbacks may lower the expected college work-study programs. The John Adams Wrestling team finished its regular season high in the N.I.C. race with a respectable 5-4 record.

After a well deserved, food-filled Christmas break, the Eagles picked up one of their N.I.C. wins by defeating a strong Elkhart Central team with a flurry of pins. The final score showing a 37-31 Eagle victory.

The grapplers, excited by the triumph over Central, came out looking for blood against Washington and slaughtered their squad by a score of 59-11. Eagle freshmen pinned 3 out of 4 opponents in the 4 lower weights. Jerome Sherman started it off with a pin at 3:33. Paul McNarney followed Sherman's lead with a lightning-quick pin in :35. Bill Weaver pinned his man in 3:53 at 121 pounds. Co-captains Dave McNarney needed less than a minute to finish off his opponent. Todd Lentz battled to a 9-9 draw at 134 pounds.

Vince Nino, Tim Wiese and Tim Long pinned their men at 147, 157 and 169. Nino in 3:04, Wiese a mere :37 and Long in 1:21. Sean Lennon and co-captain Lamar Taylor received wins by forfeit and co-captain Steve Quimby defeated his man for a 7-6 decision.



The boos directed at the pep band prompted concern among faculty and students because the boos not only offended the pep band but also the whole concept of pep assemblies and those involved.


The apathy was noticeable before this incident.


Pep band respected
