### A Mountaineer Memory By Susan Ridgeway Jones

In 1984 Don Nehlen and the West Virginia University Mountaineers beat Penn State for the first time since 1955 in Morgantown with a 17-14 upset win. There were 64,879 people in attendance for that night game at Mountaineer Field. It was a rarity in those days for WVU to be in the national spotlight, and this game was televised in prime time on ESPN. I was 10 years old and lucky enough to be at that game with my dad. We had season tickets that year in the very last row of the upper deck. The energy that night was unbelievable. I can still remember the lights, the noise and the excitement around the game. It was like nothing I had experienced before. The game was back and forth affair. Up 10-7 in the fourth quarter, the Mountaineers forced a fumble and would eventually take it in for a touchdown to give the Mountaineers a 17-7 lead. After 29 years of futility we started to hold our breathe and dare hope that that this would be the year the team would not fall apart. *(Continued on page 4)*

## Greater Cincinnati/Dayton WVU Alumni Chapter Scholarship

For the past 18 years the Cincinnati/Dayton WVU Alumni Chapter has provided at least one \$1000 per year scholarship to a local student who attends WVU. The scholarship is one of the ways our chapter gives back to our alma mater and to the local community. To date our chapter has given out over \$20,000 to help support local students. Our endowment provides approximately \$1000 each year in perpetuity for a deserving student in our area to attend WVU. This year we gave out two scholarships (one from the endowment and one funded primarily from annual chapter membership dues). Our goal is to continue to build our endowment so that additional scholarships can be offered. The current value of our endowment is over \$40,000. The near term goal to grow our endowment to \$50,000 so that we can offer an additional scholarship.

Knowing the pandemonium that was likely to ensue after the game and concerned about my safety, dad decided it was best to leave a few minutes early. We headed towards town and to a local bar to watch the end of the game. My dad says we went to Gene's, but I say we went to Marios. I just know we watched on television as fans tore down the goal posts after the game and carried them down the streets of Morgantown. WVU went on that year to an 8-4 season with a victory in the Bluebonnet Bowl over future conference mate TCU.

Even though we are now living 300 miles from WVU West Virginia is still home. We still reminisce about that day from time to time and it is still one of my best Mountaineer memories. WVU will renew its rivalry with Penn State on September 2, 2023 in Happy Valley and in Morgantown on August 31, 2024. I hope I am lucky enough to be at both of those games. I have been waiting a long time for this series to be renewed as I have been married to my husband Steve, a Penn State alumnus for the last 15 years.
