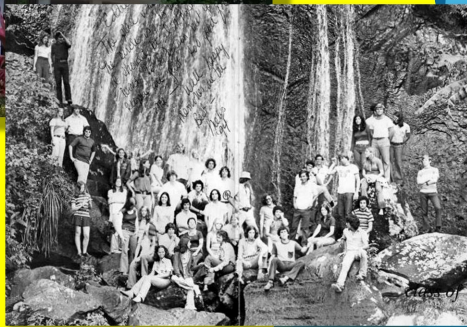

## *Robinson School* *DIDYA KNOW?*



### THROUGH THE YEARS

- 1902** • Founded as the San Juan Orphanage for Girls.
- 1905** • Introduced Puerto Rico's first Kindergarten education program.
- 1906** • George O. Robinson purchases Nairn Street location for \$10,000. School is renamed in honor of its benefactor.
- 1918** • Accredited by the Department of Instruction through eighth grade. High School students attended Central High School.
- 1923** • Orvis Hall – East Wing added, accommodating 1<sup>st</sup> – 4<sup>th</sup> grades.
- 1941-45** • Construction of Ida Haslup Goode Hall with room for 120 boarding students.
- 1944** • Robinson becomes a coeducational institution.
- 1947** • First High School Graduating Class (All Girls).
- 1950** • Construction of Pfeiffer House, residence for boarding faculty. Today it houses the school's Administration Offices.
- 1956** • School accredited by Middle States Association.
- 1959** • Boarding School closed.
- 1961** • Construction of Library and Science additions.
- 1967** • Construction of Gymnasium-Auditorium.
- 1976** • Robinson School Board of Directors was established.
- 1977** • Incorporated in the Commonwealth of Puerto Rico as a not-for-profit, private, college preparatory, English language school from grades Kindergarten through Twelfth.
- 1984** • Learning Center opens. It is the first program for children with specific learning disabilities within a college preparatory curriculum.
- 1991** • Expands Preschool curriculum to include children from 3-5 years of age.
- 1992** • First All Robinson School Reunion - 90<sup>th</sup> Anniversary. Robinson School Alumni Association formed.

- 2002** • 100<sup>th</sup> Anniversary Celebration!
- 2009** • New building for modern classrooms unveiled. The Learning Center celebrates its 25<sup>th</sup> anniversary. The program is renamed "Pathways".
- 2011** • International Boarding School opens.
- 2015** • Opens Toddler Program
- 2016** • 1<sup>st</sup> school in San Juan to be accepted as an International Baccalaureate® World School, presently for the Primary Years Program (PVP).
- 2017** • Authorized for IB Middle Years Programme (MVP).
- 2018** • Authorized for IB Diploma Programme (DP).
- 2022** • Celebrates status as an International IB Continuum World School.
