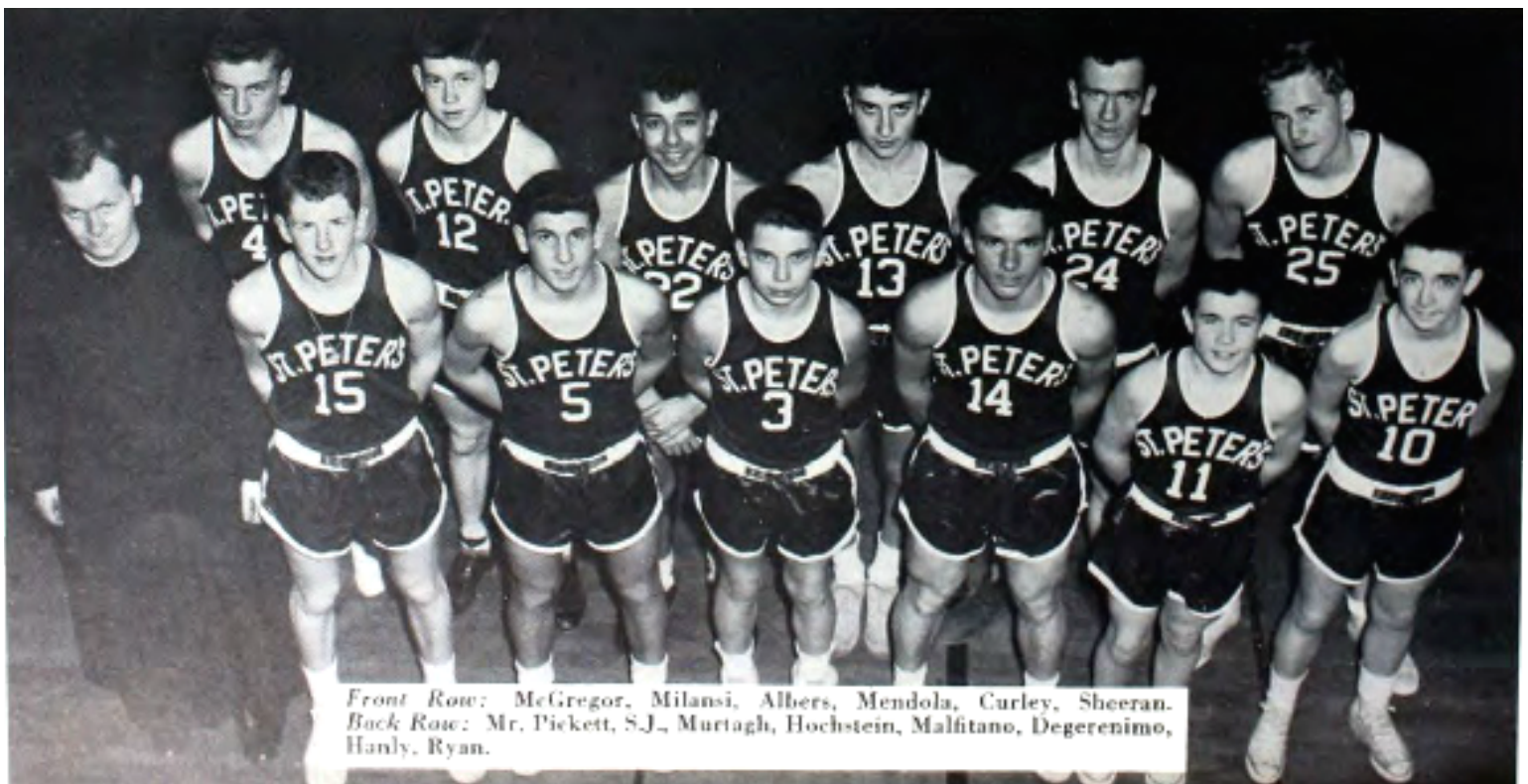

OBrienFuneralHome.com. Dr. Milanesi attended Eastern Military Academy, Stevens Academy (1962), Brown University (B.A., 1966), Fairleigh Dickinson University (M.S., 1968), Rutgers University (Ph.D. , 1971), and the College of Medicine and Dentistry of New Jersey (Doctor of Medicine, 1976).

A skilled orthopedic surgeon, Dr. Milanesi trained at Boston University under the renowned Dr. Robert Leach, assisting in developing innovative arthroscopic surgical procedures. He started his solo sports medicine orthopedic practice in Madison, N.J., in the early 1980's, practicing at Morristown Medical Center and following the career path of his father, Dr. Armand Milanesi.

An accomplished athlete, "Albie" was co-captain of the Stevens Academy 1962 State Group 2 Prep Championship basketball team. He won the 1962 North Hudson County basketball scoring championship with 677 points, averaging 27 points per game, finishing his high school career with 1,208 points, earning Prep First Team All State and Hudson County honors. He went on to letter two seasons in basketball at Brown University.

After coming to faith in the Lord Jesus Christ in February of 1995, he served as a deacon at Silver Lake Baptist Church in Belleville, N.J., and was active in attending churches in both New Jersey and Florida. Albie's love, dedication and passion touched the lives of his family, friends, patients, and co-workers. His spirit, energy and soul live forever in our hearts.

Albert was the beloved husband of Anne (McFadden); father of Armand (wife, Ellen) and Mary (husband, Matt); loving grandfather to Chloe, AnnaBea, Charlotte, Evan, Mathew, Kathryn and Peter; beloved son to Dr. Armand Milanesi (deceased) and Edith Milanesi; and beloved brother to Barbara Murphy (husband, Gerald), Joan Masella (husband, Robert), Dr. Gary Milanesi (wife, Mary).
