Obituary for Joseph Bozza

Joseph D. Bozza, 69, of Spring Lake Heights, passed away on Thursday, February 26, 2015, after a brief and courageous battle with melanoma.

Mr. Bozza was born and raised in Jersey City, and lived in Spring Lake for many years before moving to Spring Lake Heights five years ago.

He was a proud alumnus of St. Peter's Prep, St. Peter's College, and Villanova University School of Law. He was a self-employed attorney and had practiced law in Jersey City for many years until his retirement in 2012. He was a member of the New Jersey Bar Association.
