Complete coverage of St. Peter's Prep's 62-7 rout of Union City

All it took was 25 seconds for No. 3 **St. Peter's Prep** to get on the board on Saturday. Senior running back **Corey Caddle**, who finished with 117 yards, took a handoff from quarterback **Brandon Wimbrush**, sliced and diced his way through the **Union City** defense and scored on a 96-yard play.

For the remaining 47:35, it was all Marauders. St. Peter's Prep defeated the No. 16 Soaring Eagles 62-7 on Saturday, showcasing their high-octane offense throughout. Union City had no answer for the strong play of Wimbrush and his numerous weapons.

The future Notre Dame signal caller, who was pulled at the end of the third quarter, was 8-of-9 for 245 yards and three touchdowns. The four-star quarterback added 57 yards and another touchdown on the ground.

As for **Minkah Fitzpatrick**, he had a day to remember, finishing with 188 receiving yards, 43 rushing yards and five total touchdowns. The Alabama commit had three receiving touchdowns, one rushing score and a 22-yard interception return for a touchdown.

“We were rolling,” Wimbush said. “Our first play was a 96-yard touchdown run by Corey Caddle and after that, we just continued to roll. The chemistry was there with the guys and we just kept going.”

Union City’s **Jonathan Castellano** had the lone touchdown for the Soaring Eagles in the second quarter, scoring from 38 yards out. Other than that, though, Union City’s offense was held in check, allowing St. Peter’s Prep’s offense to go on the field and put the points on the board.

“Our goal was just to come out here and play four quarters,” St. Peter’s Prep head coach Rich Hansen said. “I thought we protected pretty well and run-blocked well. We had a couple of guys rush for over 100 yards and Brandon threw for around 250 yards. We were efficient on offense.”

The Marauders are now 6-1 on the season, while the Soaring Eagles are 5-2.

In early January, **St. Peter's Prep** linebacker **Jordan Fox** will pack his bags and head for the sunshine in California. Why? Because he'll be playing in the prestigious 2015 Semper Fidelis All-American Bowl.

Prior to kickoff of Saturday's matchup between the Marauders and Union City, two members of the United States Marine Corps presented Fox with his jersey and a game ball (see video above). The bowl is scheduled for Jan. 4 in Carson, Calif., and will be televised by Fox Sports 1.



Fox told NJ Advance Media last week it was a true honor to receive the invitation.

"It was amazing feeling being invited to the Semper-Fi All-American game," Fox said. "I am truly blessed with this great opportunity."

During the presentation, Fox's mother and father both made their way to midfield to see their son be honored. His father, Daniel, was brimming with pride.

"I'm very excited for him," Daniel Fox said. "From when he was a young boy, to now, he's been working hard. For him to be honored like this is special for him, more so than for us. We're just so happy for him."

Jordan Fox, ranked the No. 22 prospect in New Jersey, is in the process of scheduling official visits, Daniel Fox said.

The 6-3, 220-pounder is down to **Stanford**,
