16,876 Food Items and Counting!

With just one day left in the Great Ignatian Challenge, Prep holds the lead in the number of food items collected with 16,876 (both in-person donations, and those contributed through YouGiveGoods.com, which were delivered Wednesday). That's more than five times last year's Thanksgiving food drive total! At an average of 17.6 cans per student, Prep still trails Regis and Loyola in the standings due to their smaller student populations. Any last-minute donations to Prep's Thanksgiving food drive are still welcome, and will count toward the challenge through Friday.



If you've ever wondered what 13,810 canned food items look like, wonder no more! The items pictured were dropped off Wednesday after being donated through YouGiveGoods.com by members of the Prep community – and will go a long way in helping the families who rely on Prep's food pantry.



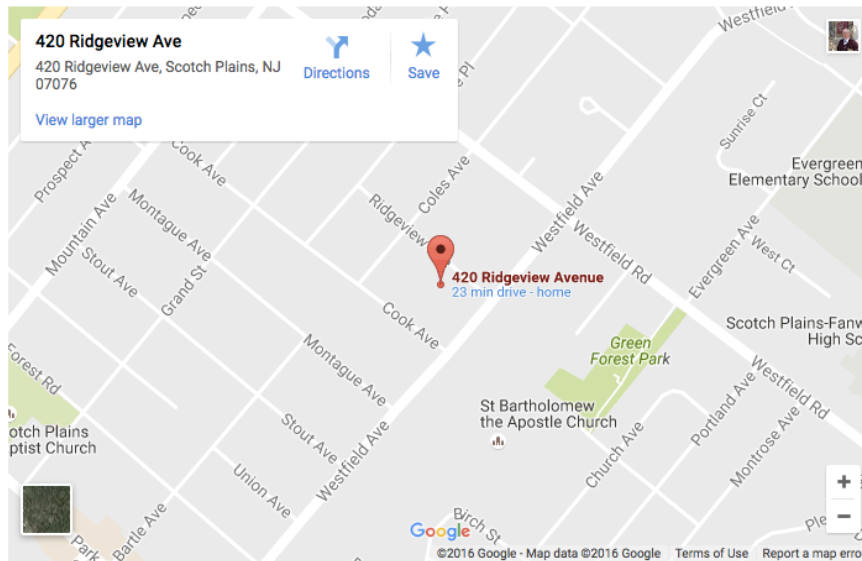
