Prep Senior Accepts Baseball Scholarship

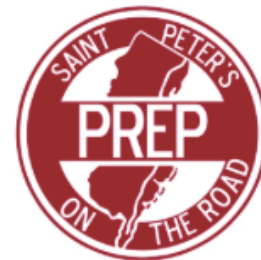
