For the famously self-effacing DeLo (asked in 2009 what had kept him at Prep for so long, he joked, "The free parking, and the summers off," before adding, "But how many people have the opportunity to do for a living what they have a passion for?"), the outpouring of appreciation was overwhelming. "Ever since my wife retired three years ago, people ask me, 'Are you still working?'" he said. "And I say to them, 'Honestly, I never worked a day in my life. It was all fun.' And I look at you guys, and now I know what I was saying."

"I'll never forget this day," he added. "I'll never forget what you did here."

It's safe to say that Prep will never forget what Mr. DeLorenzo did, day in and day out, since 1972.
