No. 17 St. Peter's Prep downs Bridgewater-Raritan at Dad's Club

Mike Cirilo was 2-for-3 with a double, two RBI and a run and Anthony Colegrove threw 3 1/3 strong innings in relief to pick up the victory when St. Peter's Prep, No. 17 in The Star-Ledger Top 20, prevailed in an 11-9 slugfest against Bridgewater-Raritan at the Roselle Park Dad's Club Invitational.

Colegrove allowed two runs on five hits, striking out two and walking one. St. Peter's Prep jumped out to a 6-0 lead after an inning and led, 9-2, after two before Bridgewater-Raritan pulled back into the game with a four-run fourth to make it 9-7.

Bridgewater-Raritan had seven extra-base hits in the game. Guy Izzo was 2-for-3 with a two-run home run and three RBI. Michael Fair hit a solo homer. Glen Boehme was 2-for-3 with two triples, three runs and an RBI. Kevin McDermott and Alex Thul were each 2-for-3 with a double and an RBI, while John Capra also had a double and an RBI and Dan Cooney delivered a two-run single.

Corey Caddle was 2-for-4 with two runs and an RBI and Nick Camilleri was 2-for-4 for St. Peter's Prep, which took an 11-7 lead in the fifth before Bridgewater-Raritan scored two in the seventh and brought the tying run to the plate before Colegrove closed it out.

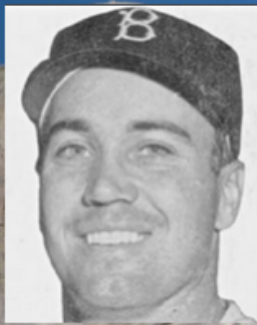

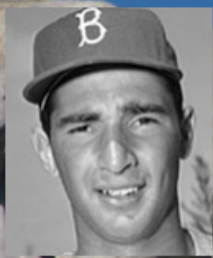

Gators Blaze Up the Track on Final Day of 2014 Pepsi Florida Relays

GAINESVILLE, Fla. -- Two 4x4 school records, including the second-fastest 4x4 in collegiate history on the men's side (2:59.73), two world-leading marks and plenty of PRs and season-best performances capped off a fantastic edition of the Pepsi Florida Relays Saturday night for the University of Florida Gators at Percy Beard Track in Gainesville, where over 4,000 track and field fans filled the stands throughout the span of the three-day event.

Stellar as it was, the women's success set up one of the most thrilling races in collegiate history to end #FLRelays14. The likes of LaShawn Merritt, Bershawn Jackson, Michael Bingham, Tony McQuay, Christian Taylor, Torrin Lawrence, Kerron Clement, Manteo Mitchell and Jeremy Wariner laced a loaded field in the first heat of the men's 4x4, but Gators Najee Glass, Hugh Graham, Jr., Dedric Dukes and Gino Hall were up for the challenge, and in a big way.

Glass, Graham, Jr., and Dukes – all All-Americans and NCAA Champions themselves – lit it up against the decorated field of Olympic medalists, former All-Americans, world and NCAA champions, holding their own for the first three legs of the slugfest before Dukes passed to Hall on the final exchange with the Gators in third. Hall cruised, making up time on the straightaways and down the final 50-meter stretch, found himself in a Gator vs. Gator battle with Clement, setting up an amazing finish that saw Hall buckle down after a 43.7 anchor leg to edge out the Gainesville Elite squad, 2:59.73 to 2:59.76.

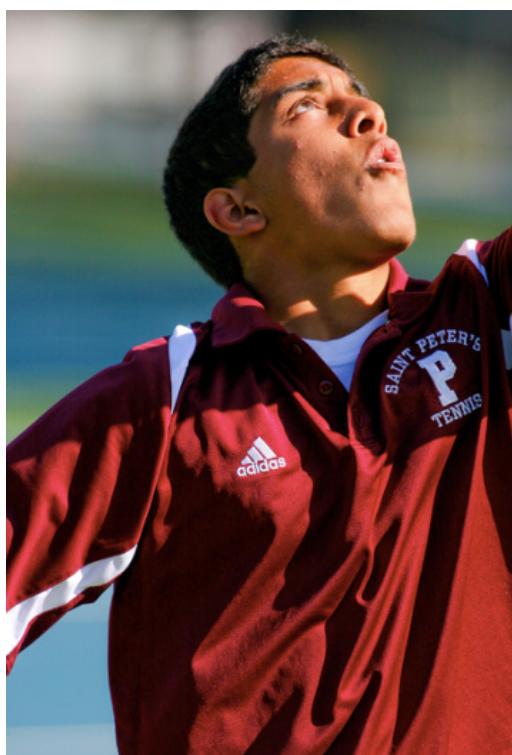

Bergen Catholic earns fifth straight Blue Devil Invitational title without veteran coach.

It was the first tournament Bergen Catholic coach Jim Jacobsen missed in his 32-year tenure. But even without the veteran leader, who was out sick, the result was the same: a title.

The Oradell school showcased its depth and was balanced from the top of the card to the bottom when it edged Oratory by one stroke to capture its fifth straight title at the Blue Devil Invitational yesterday at Echo Lake Country Club in Westfield.

Kieran Purcell of St. Peter's Prep also earned a one-stroke victory over Oratory's John Felitto (Oratory) to take the individual crown. The University of Delaware-bound senior shot an even-par 47 in the 12-hole competition to earn the victory.

"On my last hole, the second hole, I was playing against John (Felitto), who finished second," Purcell said. "He drove it on the green and I hit way left. But then got it up there to about 12 feet and he missed about a six- or seven-footer. That was huge."
