Alder Street Pod Food Carts - “Portland’s hottest food trend”

By far Portland’s hottest food trend contribution has been its prolific, hyper-specialized food cart culture. While an economic downturn forced some brick and mortar restaurants to close, Rose City’s industrious entrepreneur chef types doubled down on food carts, niching out in obscure cuisine, creative new takes on old favorites, or focusing exclusively on perfecting or riffing on that one great dish.
