Meeting Notes

- 1 **Friday Night Kickoff** - The Committee's choice to host the kickoff of 30th reunion weekend is The Fountains Lagoon Bar and Grill, located at 1800 Sweetbay Drive in Salisbury, Maryland. Different entertainers perform at the Bar and Grill as well as regulars including Sugar Fire Saranade (Top 40 duo), Zen Monkeys (Folk Rock Band) and Zion Raggae Band (Jamaican music). Although not sure what band will be around next year, it's sure to be a hit.



- 2 **Saturday Night Dinner/Dancing** - Chef Fred's (formerly Webster's) located at 1801 N. Salisbury Boulevard, Salisbury, Maryland, was chosen as the location for our dinner and dancing portion of our 30th reunion weekend to be held on Saturday. The banquet hall portion of Chef Fred's, the Chateau de Ville Banquet Center will accommodate up to 200 people with the inclusion of a dance floor. We've sent in our deposit and will work with the catering staff to finalize a menu.



- 3 **Sunday Family Picnic** - To finish off the weekend, the Committee chose Winter Place Park in Salisbury, Maryland, to have a low-key family friendly picnic. Encompassing more than 377 acres, Winter Place Park is Wicomico County's largest park facility and is broken into four components. The first of which is many wooded acres providing fantastic walking and cross country trails. A picturesque community park makes up the second portion and includes two softball fields, two sand/beach volleyball courts, playground equipment and a pavilion, parking for 200+ vehicles, as well as access to restroom facilities. And the Winter Place property is also home to the Wicomico Equestrian Center and the East Salisbury Little League. This park is accessed easily from Route 50 and the Route 13/50 Salisbury Bypass. Details are still being worked out.
- 4 **DJ** - ED Rock Entertainment (Ed Simpson) was chosen as our DJ for Saturday evening. Known as Delmarva's premier DJ Service, Ed does anniversaries, weddings, reunions, parties, corporate functions, fund raisers, or any event where music is on the menu. More than just a music service, he will coordinate and emcee the evening, which will allow all attendees to relax and enjoy the fun. He promises to have well-kept, state-of-the-art sound equipment and a play list that is structured to keep us dancing. If there are some favorite songs that absolutely must be played Saturday evening, shoot us an email and we'll make sure that Ed has them available.



- 5 **Photography** – Despite our best efforts, we were not able to secure a photographer that we would consider reasonable and one that would not raise the price of tickets substantially. We've come up with some other ideas including having a class friend who will take groups shots, individual or family shots as well as candid shots throughout the evening. You decide which groups you would like to be in, get your pictures taken at the appointed time and then either pick up your pictures later that evening, pick them up at the picnic on Sunday or we can make arrangements to send them to you. We've also discussed uploading them to Flickr or Shutterfly where you can pick out and purchase pictures at your leisure. If you've got another idea, we'd love to hear from you.
