

PARADE PLAN FOR PARTICIPANTS

Walkers, Bicyclists, and Classic Autos

The parade route starts at the judging station which is located at the intersection of Northwest Blvd. and Zollinger Road. Judges will be on both sides of the intersection so as we approach them, we should all wave the American flags in each vehicle as well as those the walkers are carrying. Honk your horns, wave the flags and your hands at the judges and just have fun. Show them the Class of 1962 Spirit!!

The walkers and bicyclists must assemble at Ray Insurance Company 1580 Fishinger Road parking lot no later than 7:00 AM Monday morning. The parade route on Northwest Blvd between Zollinger and Starr Roads will be closed to traffic starting at 6:00 AM.

The classic autos in the parade must leave Ray Insurance lot no later than 7:15 AM to arrive at the Nutter Hardware parking lot (Kingsdale Shopping Center) which will be our parade staging area. Our entry, all classic autos, and riders in each car, must report to the parade staging area not later than 7:30 AM as a group.

The classic autos will leave the Nutter Hardware lot staging area and proceed on the small shopping center access road which runs behind Schoedinger Funeral Home toward Northwest Blvd. The walkers and bicyclists should leave Ray Insurance lot by 7:30 AM and proceed to the parking lot behind Schoedinger. They will wait to join up with the classic cars as they proceed from the Nutter lot to Northwest Blvd. The walkers and bicyclists should arrive to the Schoedinger rear lot by 7:45 AM to be able to join with the classic cars.
