- ⇒ The **entry fee per person will be \$75** (checks payable to "Brian Martin Golf Tournament"). This includes eighteen holes of golf, goody bag, plenty of cool beverages, one raffle ticket, food following the tournament and free admission to the concert on Friday evening. Mulligans and ladies tees will also be sold for \$5 a piece.
