Creating Your Profile

You will need to make your individual profile in order to access any password protected pages on the site. Start by clicking on the **Classmate Profiles** link on the main menu. Find your name, click on it and follow the prompts to create your profile and password. The password you enter during this process will be used as your login password.


Once you create your profile you will be able to view profiles of your fellow classmates. You have the option to password protect your personal profile which blocks the general public and search engines from accessing your profile details, such as your street address, phone number and email address. When others view your name, they will see your city and state, and any other information that you choose to enter in your profile. Your email address is not viewable, though an email can be sent to you using the contact box at the bottom of your web page. If you send a message to someone through their profile, they will see your email address so they can respond.

You can personalize your page with information such as what you have been doing since graduation, school memories, your family details, photos and videos.

If you change your email address, snail mail address, phone number or any other information, update your profile to keep your information current.

If you check "Remember Me" when you log in, a cookie will be placed on your computer that will automatically enter your login information when you return to the site.. If you forget your password, click on "Forgot Password?" and your password will be sent to your email address. You can login from any computer other than your own but you will need to enter your email address and password.

How to Upload Pictures to Your Profile Page:

1. Log in on the home page. Under **MEMBER FUNCTIONS**, click on **Edit/Upload Photos**.
2. Your photo page will appear with a button title **Upload New Photo**. Click on it and the upload page will appear.
3. Click on the **Add Files** button and browse to the file location on your computer.
4. Select the file name and click the **Open/Load** button to add it to your list . To select multiple files press and hold the Ctrl key and click on each file to highlight it.
5. When all the files are listed, click the **Upload Files** button.
6. After files are uploaded you will be returned to the **Upload New Photo** page. Add captions for pictures
7. Press **Save Changes**.

The sort number controls the order in which photos display on your page. By default your pictures will appear in the order you entered them. Later if you want picture #5 to appear as #1, you will have to change the sort numbers on your pictures. If you delete a picture, the sort numbers for the remaining pictures do not change (e.g., if you delete picture #2 out of 4 pictures, you will show pictures #1, 3, and 4.)

Embedding YouTube videos in your Profile

On the YouTube website, make sure your video is showing in the play box. To the right of the video you'll see a gray box, and near the bottom of this box is the grayed word "Embed." And just below that a long horizontal white box that contains the code for the video. When this code is placed in the Video box on your Edit Profile page, the video player with your video will appear on your page.

Steps to place YouTube code on your page:

1. Have your video displayed in YouTube and left click once on the white window that contains the code. It should be selected and turn blue. (Alternately, you can move your mouse across the box until all the code turns blue.)
2. On your keyboard hold down the Control key (Ctrl) and press the letter C. This copies the code. (Or right-click, select copy)
3. On your Edit Profile page, locate the box "Videos".
4. Place your cursor inside the box and left click with your mouse.
5. Press the Control key and the letter V key. (Or right-click, select paste) The Embed code will appear in the Video box. The code will look similar to this:

6. In the Video Description box, enter a caption / explanation of your video which will appear below your video on your profile page.
7. Click the Save button.
