



College GPA of 2.0 or greater on a 4.0 scale is required unless otherwise specified.

Scholarships will be awarded at the May 2016 Senior Awards Ceremony, and recipients will be invited to the Annual Alumni Banquet on Saturday, June 25, 2016, where we will also be honoring Distinguished Alumni Award recipients.



1940 Class Note submitted by Doris Kirchner Magwitz

The Kenosha High School graduated 200 in January and 402 in June class of 1940. This is our 75th Anniversary. Do the math - normally being 18 at high school graduation and adding 75 puts us all at 93 years of age - give or take a couple of months. Many of those left either don't drive or are in poor health, so participating in a reunion is limited.

I was a farm girl living ten miles west of Kenosha on Hwy. 50 - today Bristol Oaks Golf course abuts the west fence line. I rode in car pools - no buses then. Drivers were either using their Dad's car, someone working in Kenosha with hours to correspond to school hours, or one year it was with the neighbor senior and my neighbor, Marie Frost, in the farm pickup truck with the milk cans to be delivered to Landgren Dairy.

I attended our 25th Reunion held at the Eagles Hall, but it wasn't till after our 50th that I became active with the committee. I've never attended a school dance or football game.

We have lost so many key committee people over the years – one in particular being Irene Buri Nelson. Along with the Eagles Club many reunions were held at Kenosha Country Club, but as attendance declined we opted for the Fireside Restaurant or HobNob. Fred Nyberg was our treasurer. About ten years ago we quit mailings, closed the account and gave the remaining funds to the Alumni Association. Now the group meets semi-annually for a "Dutch-Treat" noon luncheon. (No more night driving.)

Our class colors are light blue and yellow with a yellow rose as class flower. Gilbert Raanich was President; Leo Molinaro, VP; Rita Flynn, Secretary; and Jack Pope, Treasurer. Our motto is "They can who think they can." The class play was "Jonesy."


