LEO CHIAPPETTA – CLASS OF 1956

Leo worked hard to put himself through college, taking classes at UW-Kenosha Extension before going on to graduate from UW-LaCrosse (1964) with a B.S. degree in Elementary Education. His career with Racine Unified School District spanned more than 35 years, during which he taught elementary, junior high and high school and coached junior high Gymnastics and high school Tennis. Leo received his M.A. at Cardinal Stritch College (1972) with a major in Reading Supervision and a minor in Psychology. In 1992, he received certification as a Director of Instruction at UW-Milwaukee. He served many years as Supervisor of Curriculum and Instruction for RUSD's social studies program. Leo has given many reading workshops throughout Wisconsin, has published articles in two Wisconsin educational magazines and has taught college courses at Carthage College and UW-Parkside. After retiring from RUSD in 2000, Leo served as a substitute principal for several years. From 2004-2012, he worked at Carthage College as a Supervisor for Student Teachers.

Leo has served several terms on the Kenosha Public Museum (KPM) Board of Trustees, serving as president from 2008-2010, and presently is on the Foundation Board of KPM. He is past vice president of the Bradford Alumni Association. He has been recognized for his leadership and contributions to Phi Delta Kappa International and the Italian Business and Professional Association.



NAHEED QURESHI – CLASS OF 1990

Naheed Qureshi received her B.A. in Political Science from the University of Wisconsin-Madison and her J.D. from Georgetown University Law Center. Naheed spent several years working for the federal government and served as Attorney Advisor to Immigration Judge Ellen K. Thomas. She also gained experience in local government at the City of Los Angeles Department of Neighborhood Empowerment. After 9/11 she was recruited to join the U.S. Department of Justice Civil Rights Division to help shape the Initiative to Combat Post-9/11 Discrimination. She then worked for the U.S. Department of Homeland Security, where she continued her efforts to build bridges between the federal government and ethnic and immigrant communities on a national scale.

Ms. Qureshi worked for the Washington Legislative Office of the American Civil Liberties Union (ACLU). In her role as a National Field Organizer, Ms. Qureshi advanced policy issues and educated stakeholders about critical infringements on American civil liberties and freedoms.

Currently Naheed Qureshi serves as deputy director at Muslim Advocates. Ms. Qureshi was a founding board member of Muslim Advocates and served for four years as the chair of the fundraising committee. She brings to the organization a deep expertise in public policy with a focus on civil rights issues.



STATE SENATOR ROBERT W. WIRCH - CLASS OF 1961

Bob Wirch received his B.A. degree in History from UW-Parkside in 1970. Bob spent his early years working at American Brass in Kenosha. He also worked as a liaison to Job Training Partnership Act (JTPA) programs and served in the Army Reserve from 1965-1971. He was elected to serve on the Kenosha County Board (1986-1994), as a member of the State Assembly (1992-1996) and currently in the State Senate (1996-present). Senator Wirch has served as a member of the Joint Committee on Finance, responsible for working on the State of Wisconsin biannual budget. He authored and passed key legislation to protect U.S. jobs, to save taxpayers billions of dollars, and to ensure senior citizens have affordable prescription drugs.

Bob is an RSVP Volunteer, former volunteer at the Shalom Center and current donor to support the programs provided by the Shalom Center. He holds membership in many local service organizations and is a former member of the Board of Directors for the Kenosha Boys and Girls Club.

Senator Wirch has received the NEA Friend of Education Award and has been named Legislator of the Year by the Professional Fire Fighters and the Wisconsin Council of the Blind. He has also been recognized as Wisconsin Wildlife Conservation Legislator and has received the Bridges Community Center/NAMI Kenosha County David Wagner Mental Health Advocacy Award.

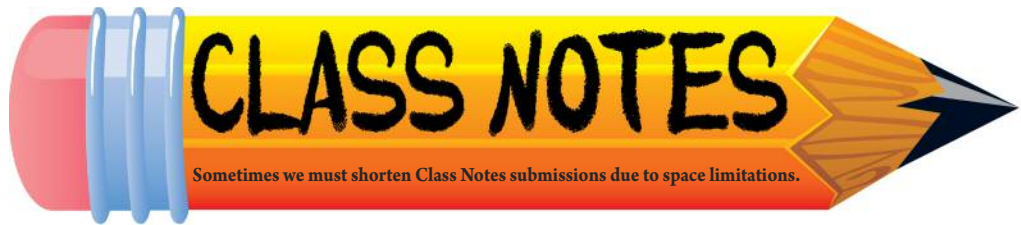

In 1891, the first graduating class of what was then Kenosha Central High School (first free high school west of the Alleghenies), founded the Alumni Association with the help of Mary D. Bradford, the teacher for whom the high school was eventually named.

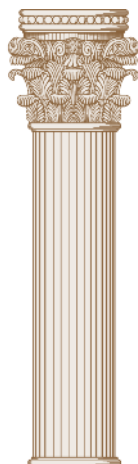

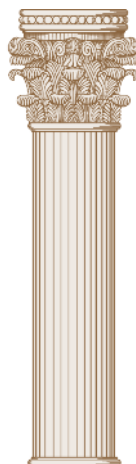
