The Urbandale Alumni Association would like to recognize and thank Margaret Ann “Boals” Boatright for serving the past eight years on the Urbandale Alumni Board. Margaret Ann was one of the original members of the Board who gathered in 2013 when it was decided to form an Alumni Association in celebration of the Urbandale Centennial in 2017.

Margaret Ann graduated from Urbandale HS in 1956. She attended K-12th grade at the building at 70th and Douglas when all grades attended in one building. She shared that during high school she was a cheerleader and sang in the girls chorus and mixed chorus. She also shared that back in the 1940's-1950's “it was like a family, as we knew everyone, even the kids in the lower grades”. The highlights of the week would be Friday nights, she said, as they would attend games and then roller skate on Saturdays. “The Urbandale Roller Rink and Emmerts was our hang out at 70th and Maryland where the street car turn around was at. There was a juke box and pinball machines, six songs for a quarter and we would dance in a tiny little space of floor. You could get a Pepsi or a hamburger. Also after the games on Fridays we would go to the Chili King for fries and a Pepsi. Life was pretty simple.”

All six of Margaret Ann's siblings, along with three of their spouses, and nieces and nephews attended Urbandale. The Boals family has a long history in the City of Urbandale and Urbandale Schools. We greatly appreciated Margaret Ann's contributions to the Alumni Association by sharing what life was like when she attended school at Urbandale. She also was able to bring graduates from the 1950's and 1960's and beyond on board with us as we attempted to connect with Urbandale graduates. Margaret Ann will be greatly missed but we know we will continue to see her at our events. Thanks for everything Margaret Ann!!!
