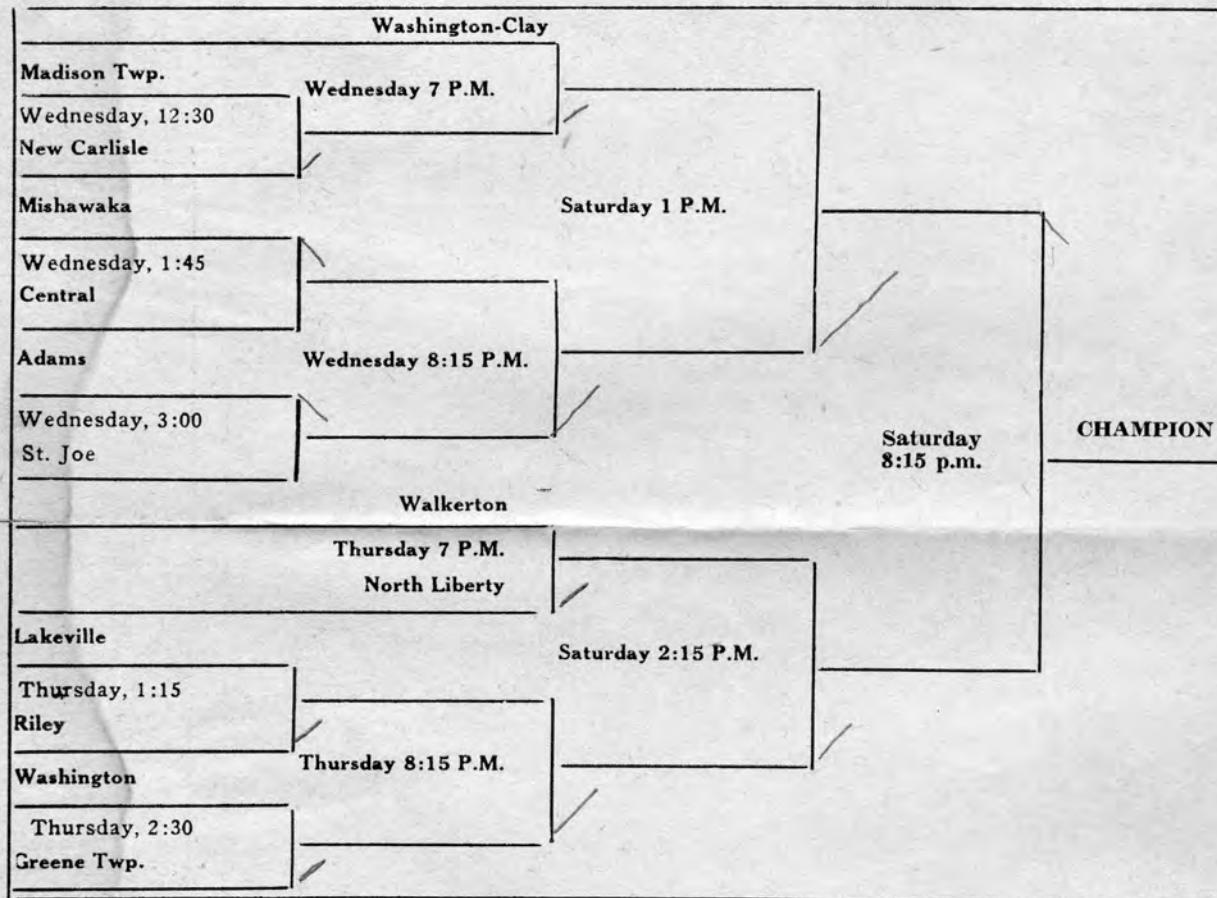

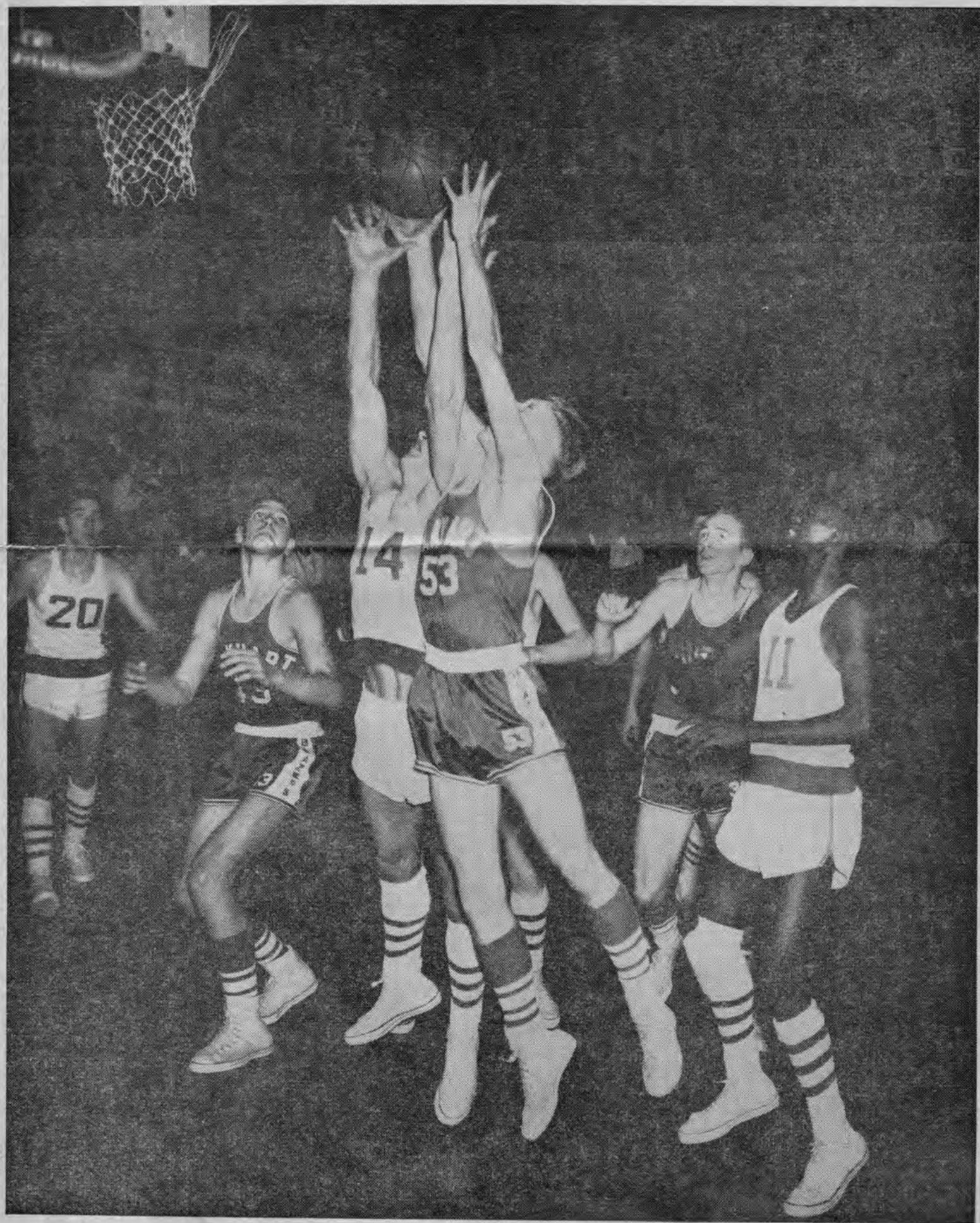

He has played B team football, basketball, and baseball. He plans to go out for baseball this spring. He is a forward. Ron Pinter is a 6'2" senior. Ron is a forward and played B team last year. Dan Jones is a 6'2" senior. Dan played

B team basketball this year. He also played B team baseball. Dan is a forward for the Cats. He is a starter.

Top row, left to right: Charlie Stewart is a 6'3" coach of the Wildcats. This is Coach Stewart's fourth season at Riley. He came from Central. Ron McElhenie is a 6'2" senior forward. This is Ron's second year on the varsity. Ron is also a track man and has won his letter in track. Ron is one of the starting Wildcats. Fred Odusch is a 6'2" senior center. Fred has received 3 letters in football, 2 in

basketball (this is his third year), and 2 in baseball. Fred is the starting center. Jack Hanks is a 6' senior guard. Jack played B team last year and also baseball. Jack was an end in football and won his sweater in that sport. Dave Young is a 5'9" senior guard. Dave has played 3 years of varsity basketball and 2 years of varsity baseball. Dave is one of the "Cats" starting five.

Gale Acton is a 5'6" junior guard. Gale has played B team basketball and baseball. This is Gale's first year on varsity basketball.
