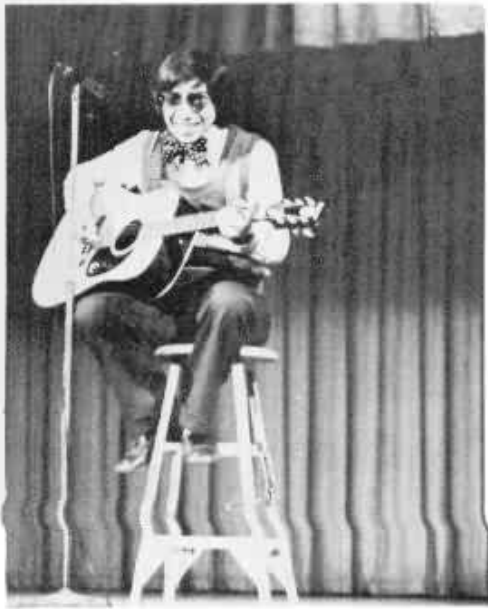

## *B.H.S. Carnival*

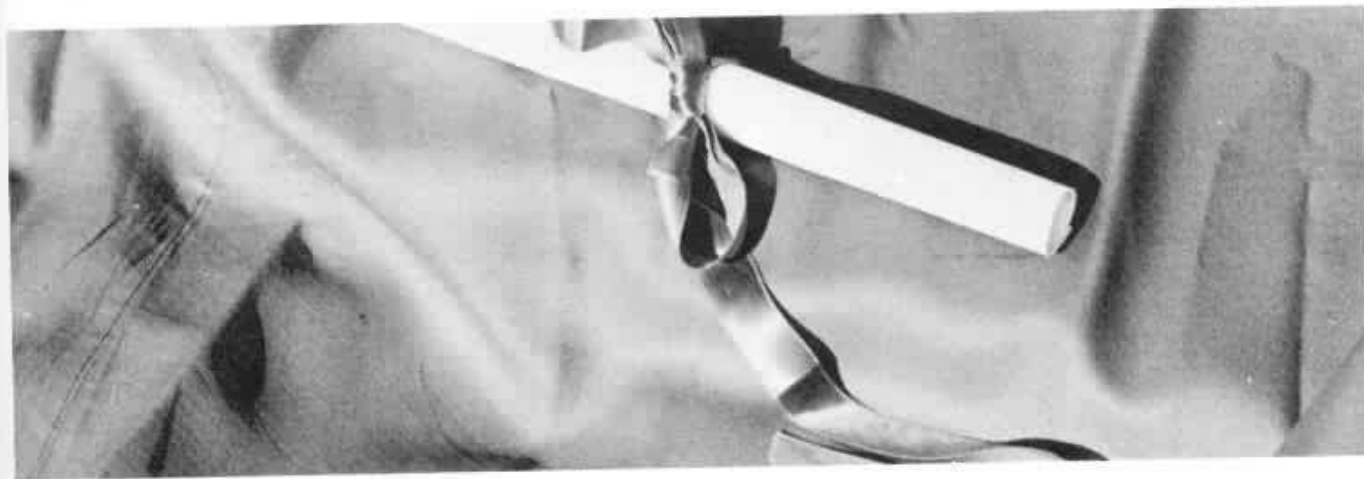

## Prom

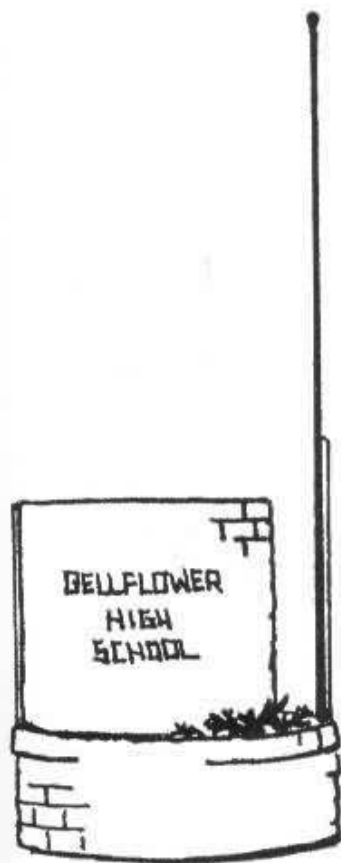

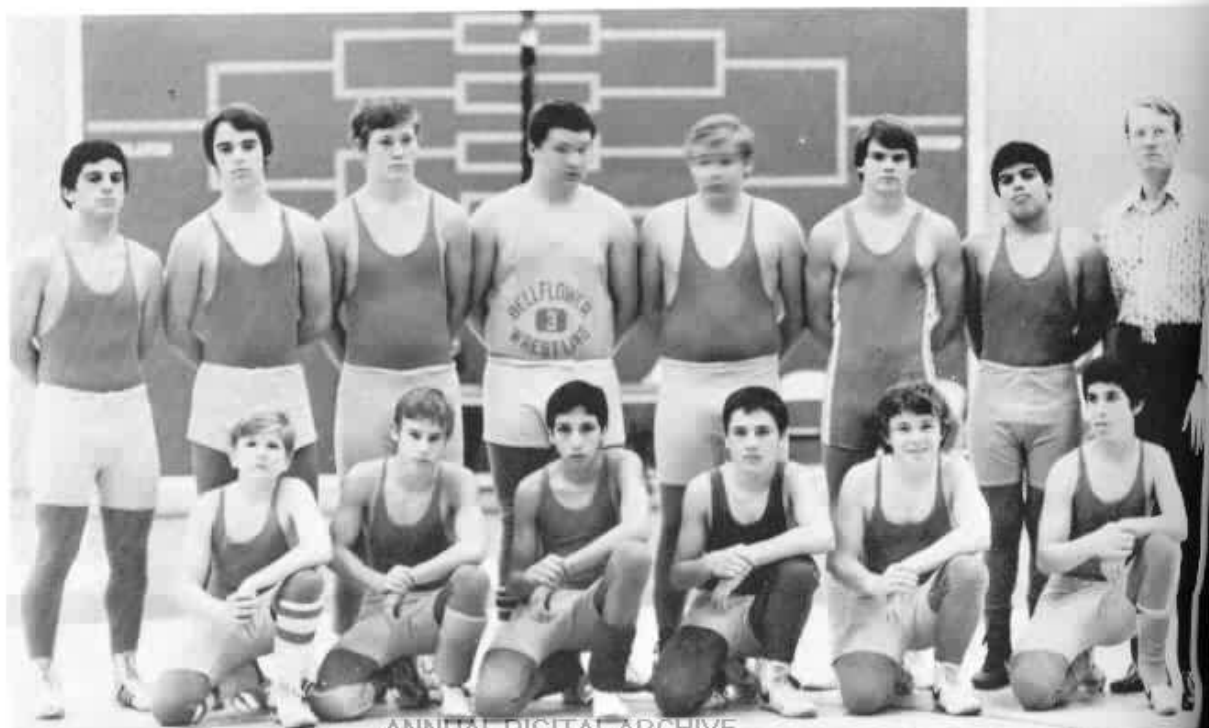
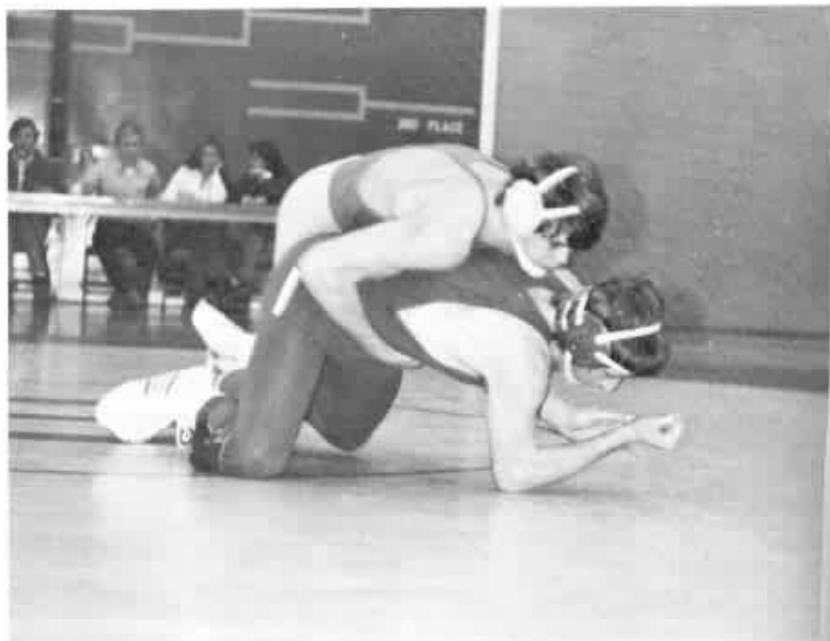
"They came with no experience, they came with much desire." If the class of '77 keeps at it, Coach Koch's wrestling team 3 years from now will destroy the league.

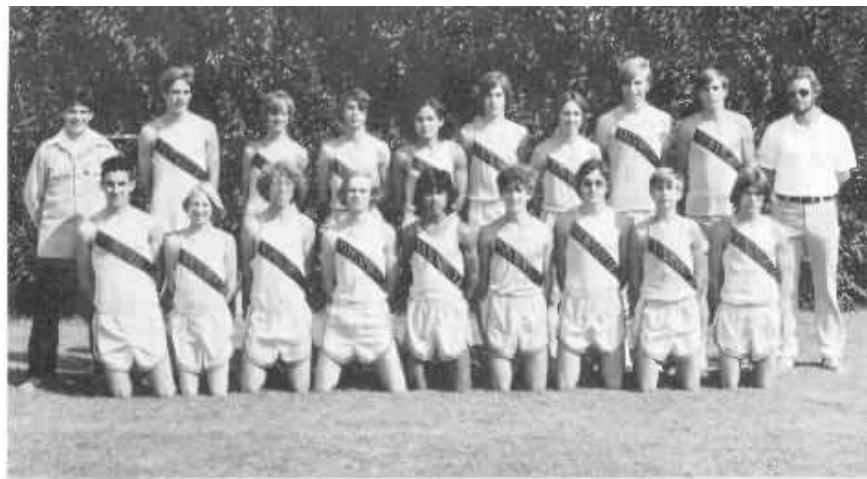
## *Intramural Sports*
